Released to the Public

- In partnership with MDE's Office of Educational Supports, the [English Learner Dashboard](#) has been updated to include four additional metrics. In addition to the assessment and growth data previously included, the dashboard now provides counts of current and exiting English Learner students, a cumulative count of former EL students and the median number of years students receive services.
- The [Special Education Data Portraits – Disability, Age Range and Educational Setting and Demographics](#) reports showing different breakouts of students who received special education services have been updated with 2020-21 data. This year's Age Range and Educational Setting and Demographics data include slight changes to the age ranges. Age 3-5 now only includes students who are not enrolled in kindergarten, and the Age 6-21 group has changed to Age 5 (in kindergarten)-21.

Coming Soon

- A new downloadable data file will be added to the [K-12 School Data Files](#). The Parent Dashboard data file will contain all available metrics at the selected location setting. School-level data can be viewed for one school, or all schools within a district, ISD or statewide. The option to download directly from the Parent Dashboard will be added in the future.
- Postsecondary data showing enrollment, credit accumulation, remedial coursework and degree attainment, along with select demographic breakdowns for each high school graduating class are packaged in the [Postsecondary Trends by High School](#) report. School year 2019-20 data will be added.
