



MI School Data News and Updates

Updated as of March 3, 2021

Released to the Public

- The [College Degrees and Certificates Awarded](#) report, which displays student achievement at Michigan's colleges and universities, has been updated with 2019-20 data.
- COVID-19 continues to affect how districts provide instruction to their students. The [Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan Dashboard](#) has been updated to include new data collected as of Feb. 17.
- The [Financial Information Reports](#) and [Financial Transparency Dashboard](#) have been updated with 2019-20 data. The dashboard gives a comprehensive view of district finances and includes five-year trend information.
- The percent of public high school students who graduated or dropped out is shown in the [Graduation/Dropout Rate](#) report. Users can view four-, five- and six-year rates for a selected school year. This report has been updated with 2019-20 data.
- The [School-Level Expenditure Report](#), which breaks down expenditures of federal, state and local funds for public schools, has been updated with 2019-20 data. Users can compare expenditures at the county, city, ISD, district or school levels with multiple visual tools.
- Pupil headcount data for 2020-21 have been added to the [Student Enrollment Counts](#) report. The report shows an unduplicated count of students attending a specific district or school.

Released in Preview

- The [Pathways to Kindergarten](#) report contains data for publicly funded early childhood education taken by students before enrollment in kindergarten. Pathways to Kindergarten shows the order in which children enrolled in various programs, including developmental kindergarten. This report has been updated with 2020-21 data, which will be publicly available

within a week.

- Annual counts and FTE of teachers, administrators, paraprofessionals and other staffing groups are included in the [Staffing Count](#) report, including breakouts by age range, longevity, race/ethnicity, gender and highest education level. The report has been updated in preview with 2020-21 data and will be publicly available within a week.

Coming Soon

- A new data file, the **Community College Demographic Enrollment Profile**, will be added to MI School Data. Starting with 2019-20 data, the file will show the number of students enrolling in and receiving degrees at Michigan community colleges by age, gender and race/ethnicity.
- Data for 2020-21 will be added to the [Foundation Allowance](#) report, which shows the amount of revenue a selected district receives from the state per student enrolled.
- The [Parent Dashboard](#) will be updated with 2019-20 graduation and dropout rates.
- Data for 2020-21 will be added to the [Quick Facts](#) report, which provides an overview of the types and counts of education buildings. Data can be viewed by state, ISD and district.
- The [Retained in Grade](#) report, which shows counts and percentages of students who were enrolled in the same grade level for two consecutive years, will be updated with 2020-21 data.
