Recently Released

- Data showing total counts, percentages and attendance rates for all students, chronically absent students and not chronically absent students for 2018-19 have been added to the [Student Attendance](#) report.
- The Ratio of Students to Instructional Staff metric on the [Parent Dashboard](#) has been updated with data for the 2018-19 school year and has a new filtering feature allowing ratios to be filtered by subject area.

Coming Soon

- The [English Learner Student Growth](#) report shows how much growth in learning the English language, as measured across two consecutive years of the WIDA ACCESS for ELLs, English learner students made in comparison to their EL peers. Data will be added for the 2018-19 school year.

The next meeting will be held on October 30, 2019, at Shiawassee RESD. Members will continue to review:

- Civil Rights Data Collection
- Michigan Profile for Healthy Youth (MiPHY)
- Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development’s (ASCD) Whole School, Whole Community, Whole Child (WSCC), and Michigan Integrated Continuous Improvement Process (MICIP)
- Existing MI School Data logins and permissions
- Previous collection of data through the Data Tools for School Improvement

The group also analyzed data types and locations (process, perception, demographic and achievement) for educator access.
