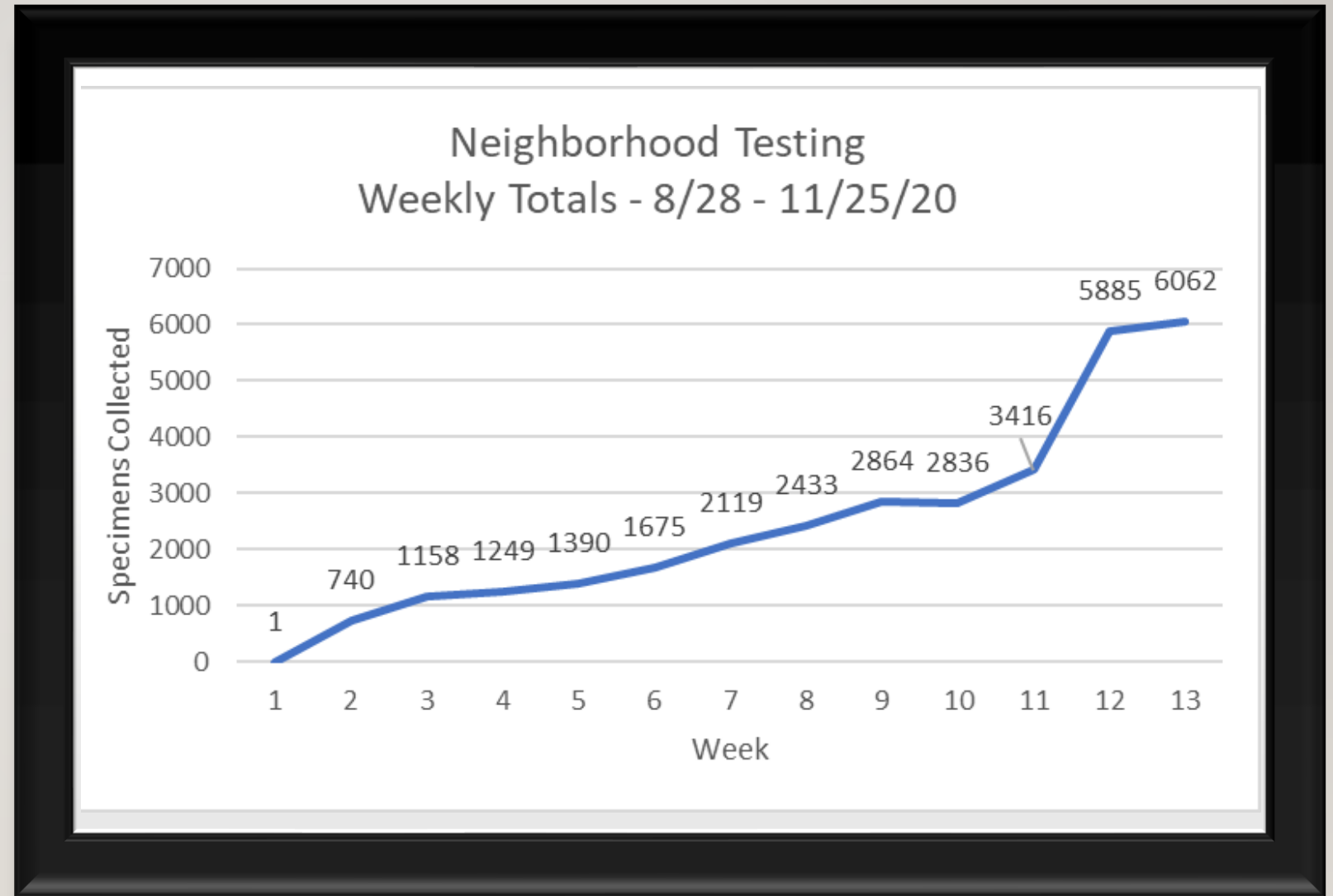


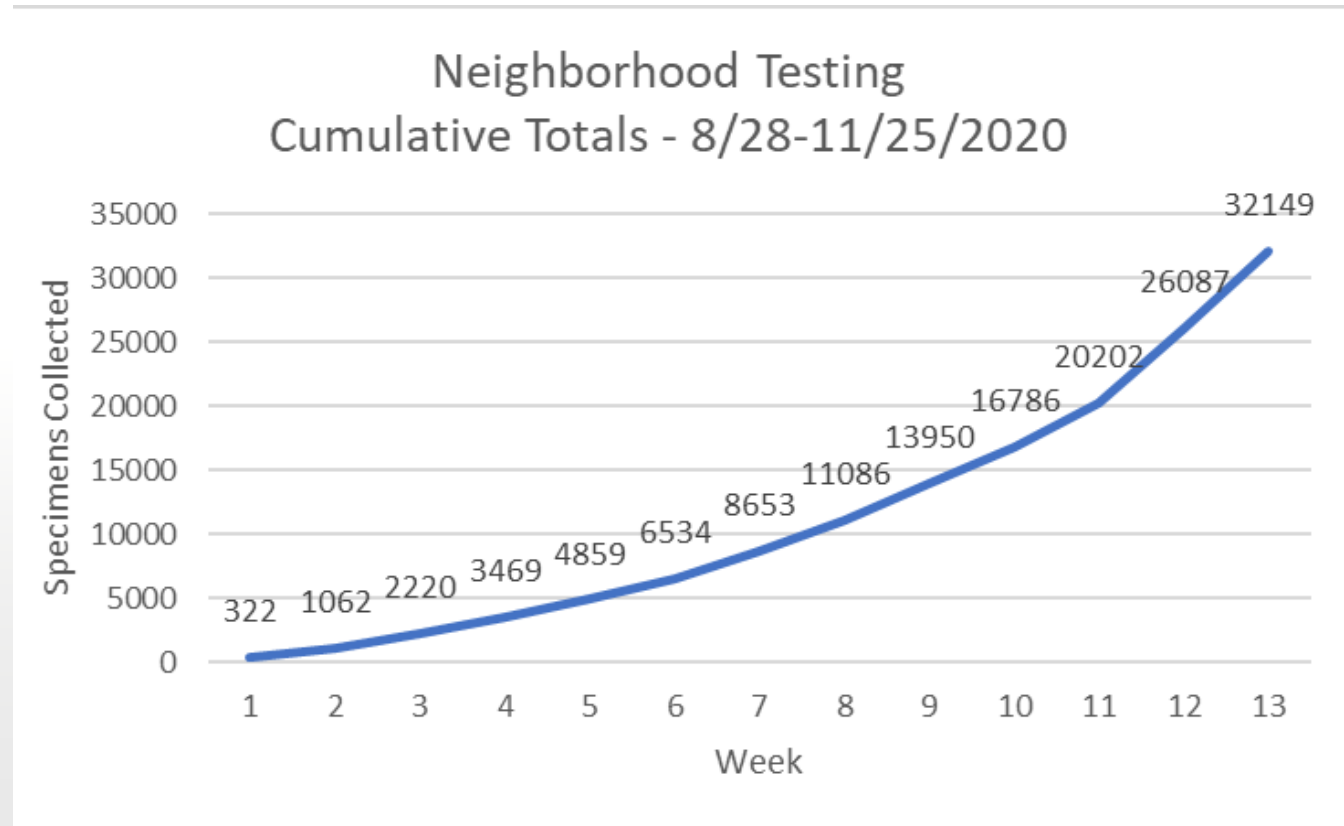

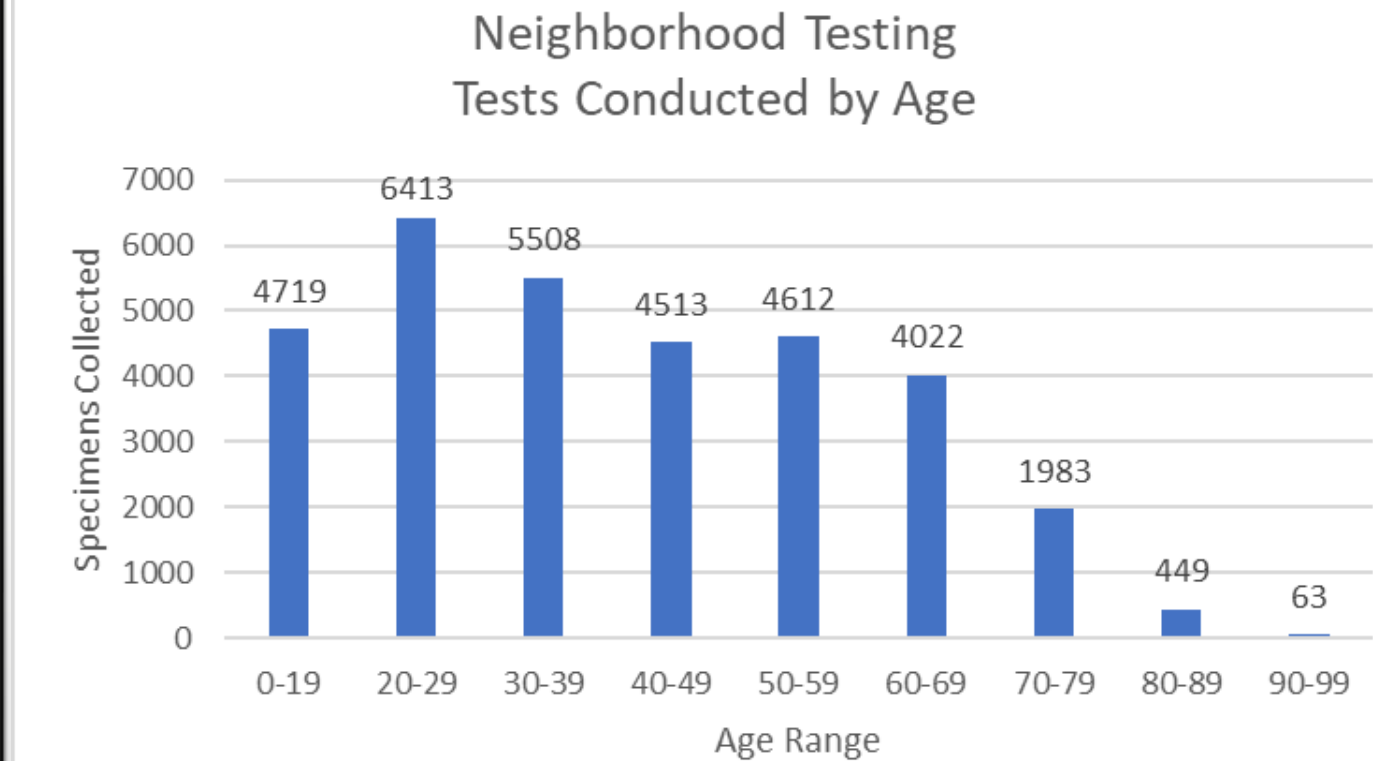
WEEKLY TESTING TOTALS



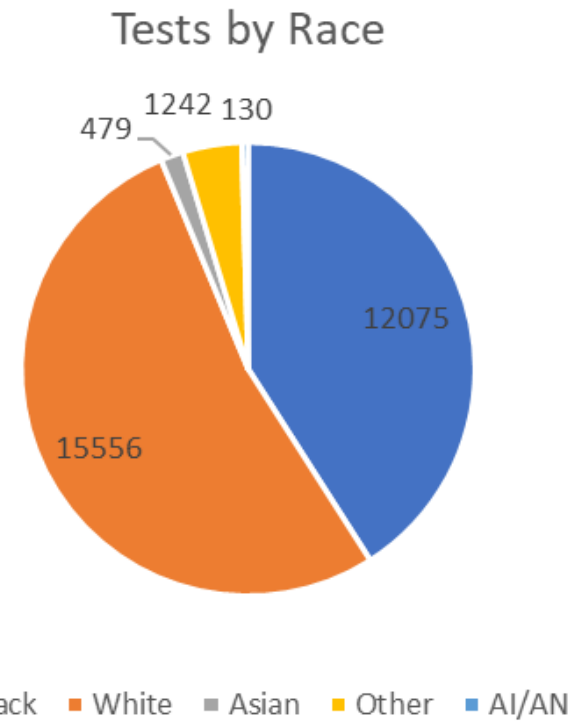
CUMULATIVE TESTING TOTALS



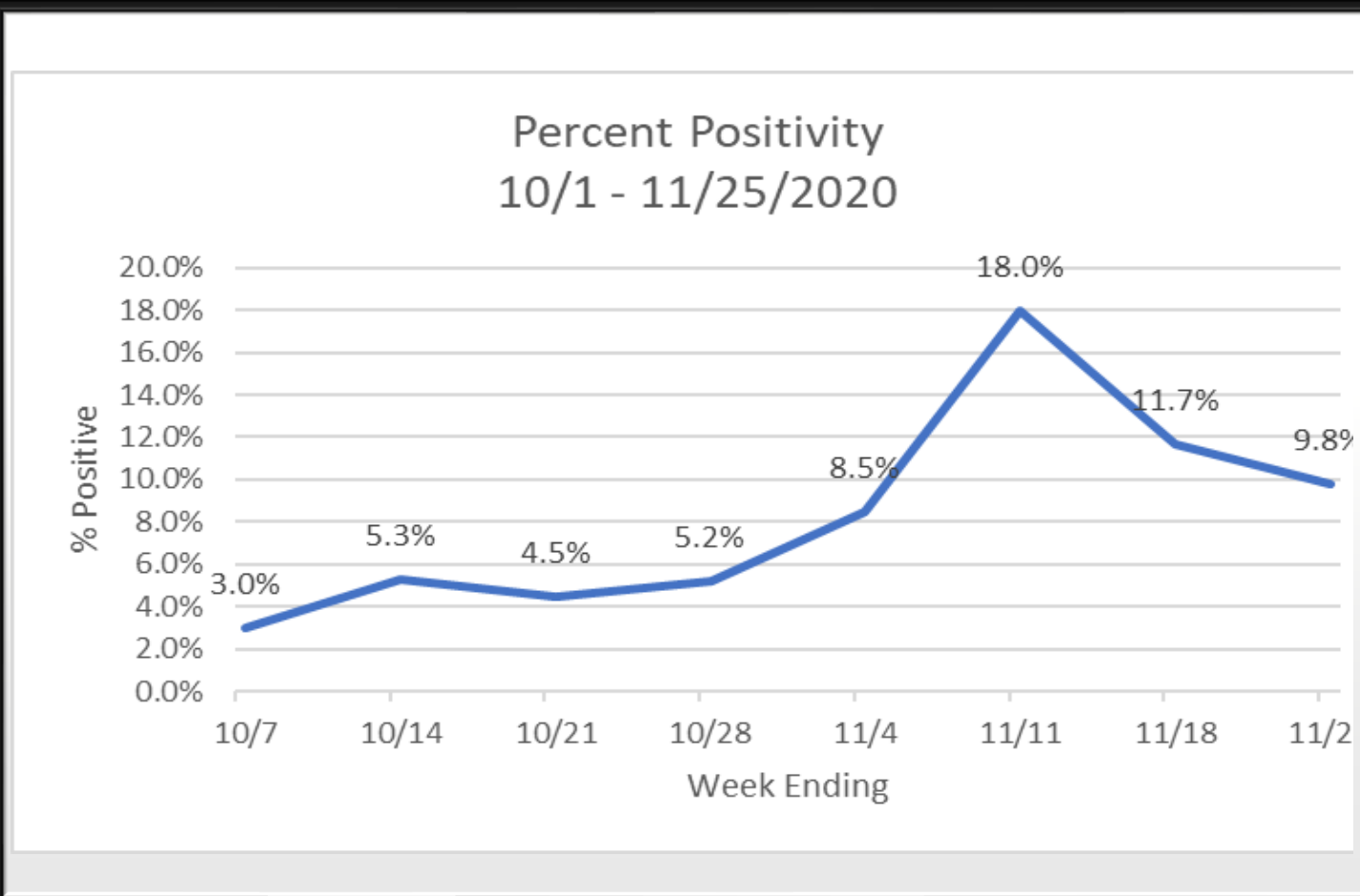
AGE DISTRIBUTION

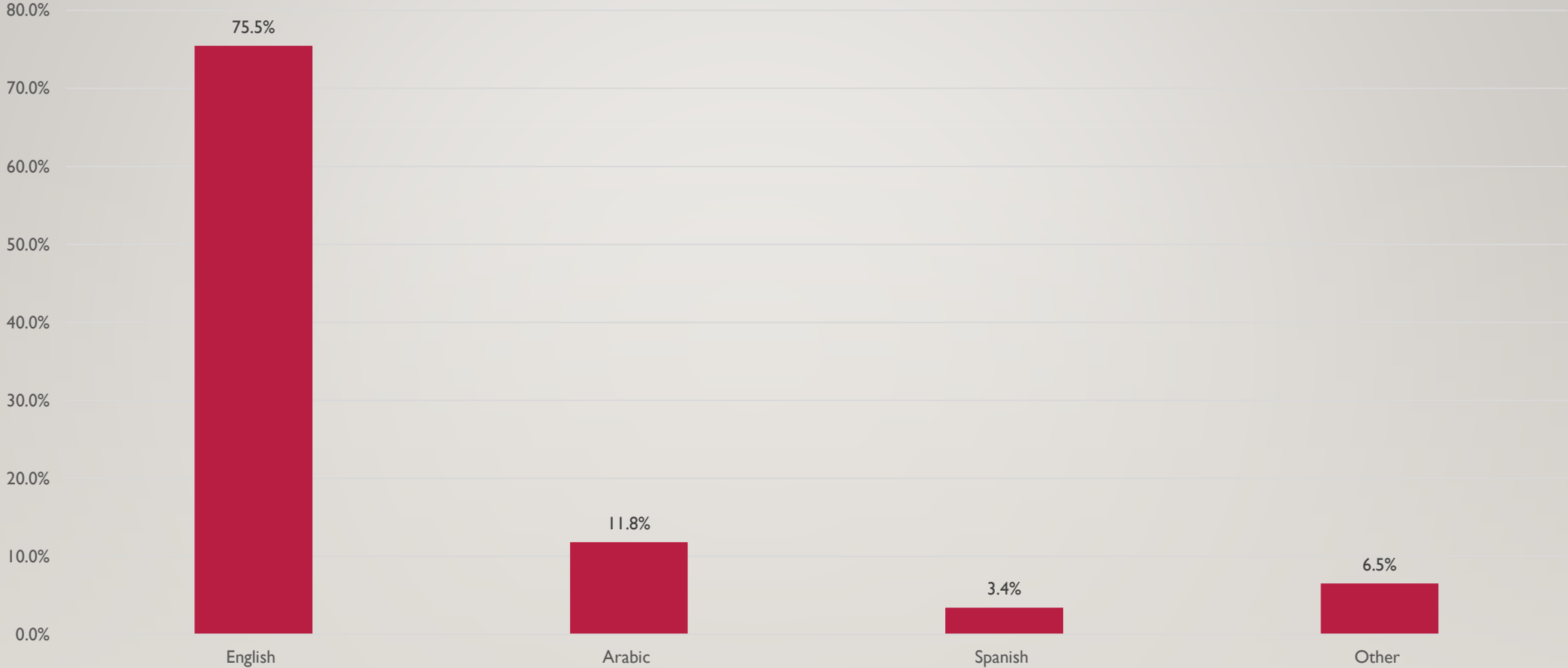
Race/Ethnicity of Participants



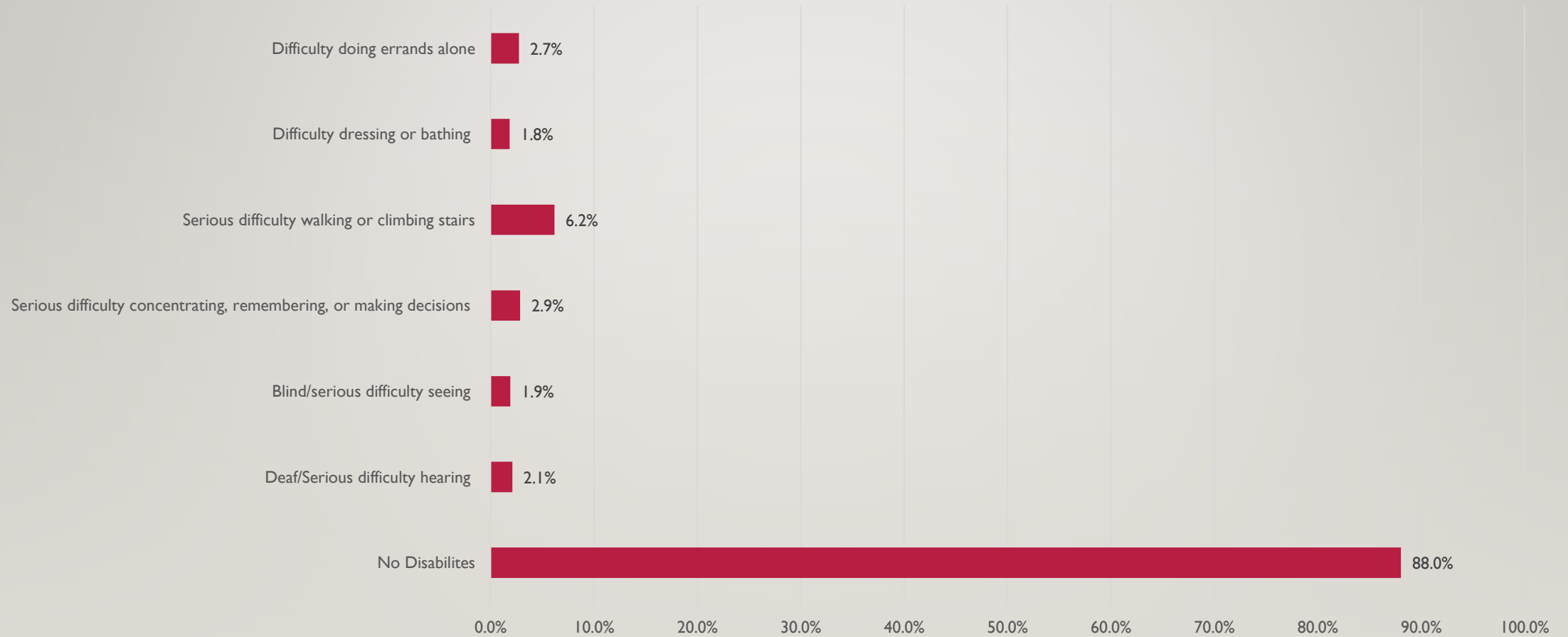
Age of Participants



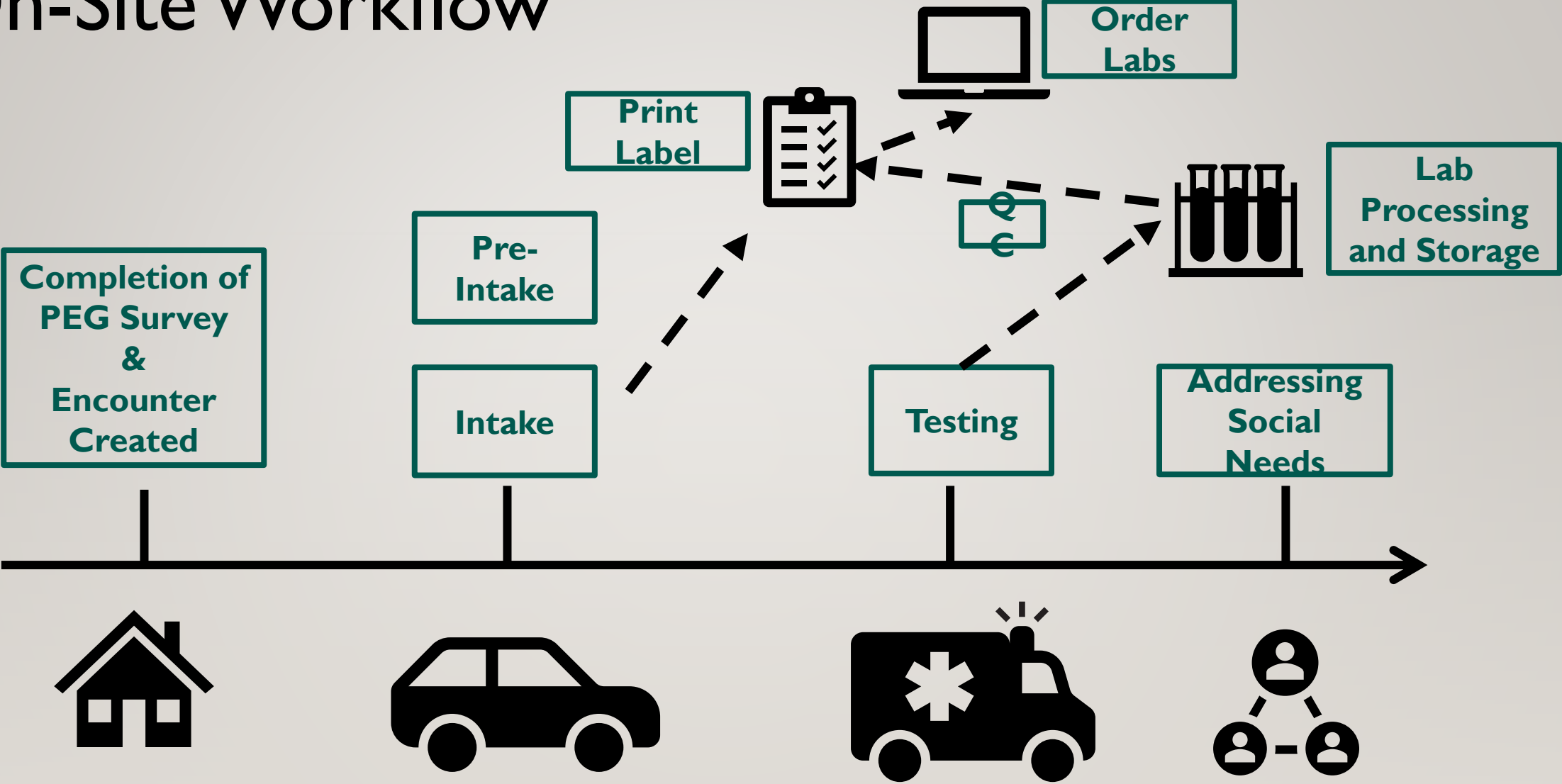
Primary Language of Participants

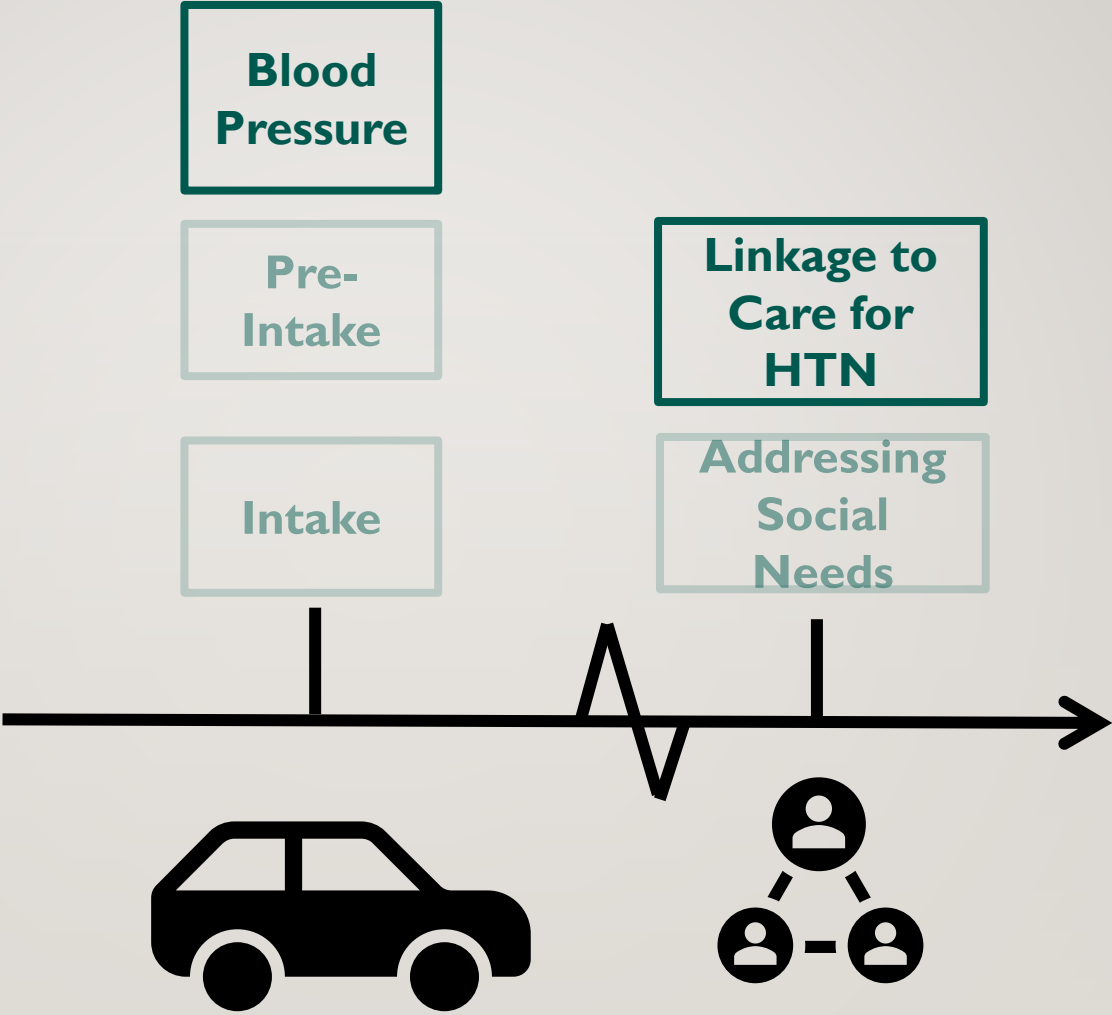
Referral Services

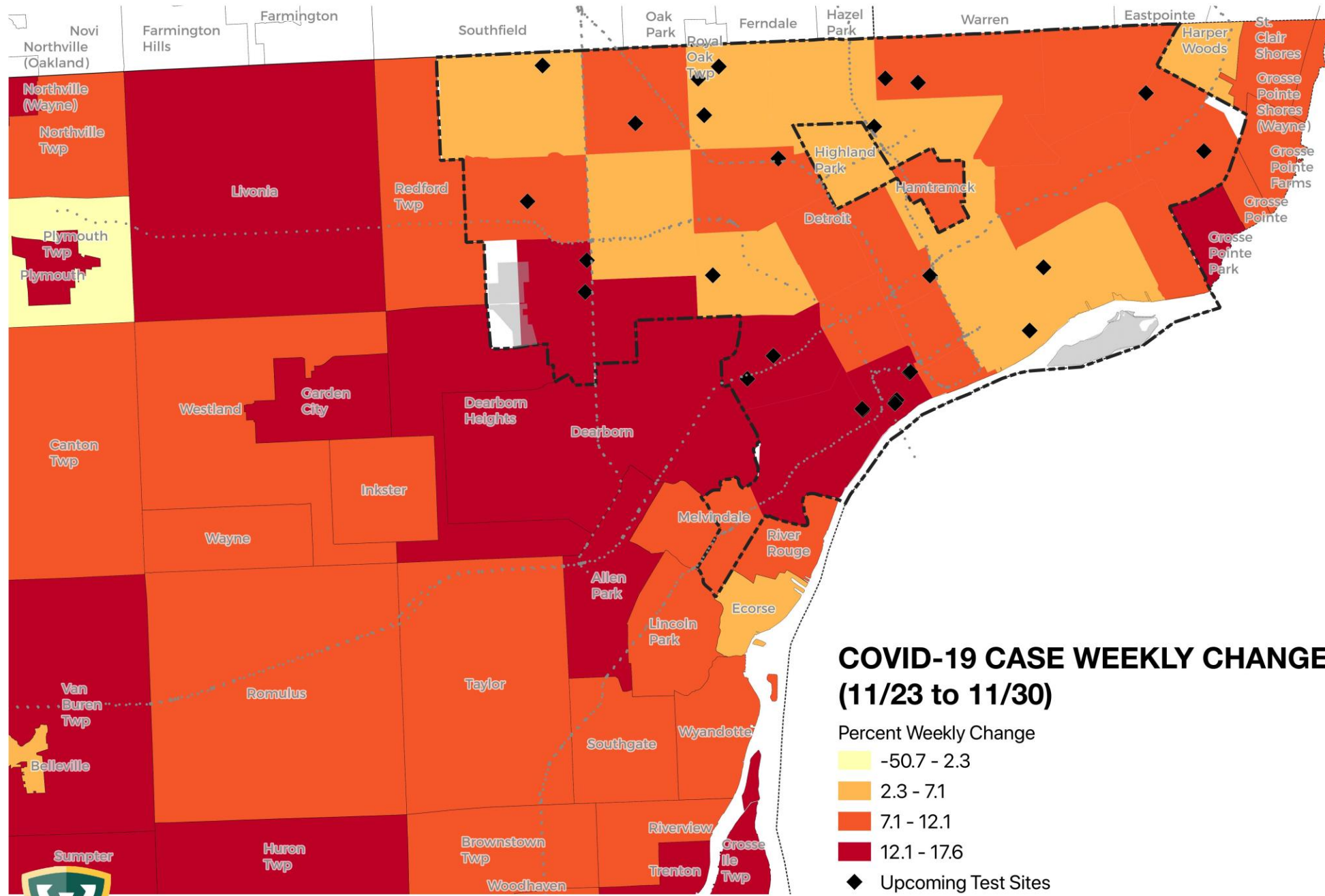
