AMENDED ORDER GRANTING PETITIONER'S MOTION TO DISMISS

On January 11, 2019, an order was entered Granting Petitioners' Motion to Dismiss.

On February 7, 2019, Respondent filed a Motion to Amend Order Granting Petitioner's Motion to Dismiss in DIFS CASE NUMBER 15-963-1 (MAHS DOCKET No. 15-040103) AND CASE NUMBER 16-9771-1 (MAHS DOCKET NO. 16-013298), which dismissed the matter without prejudice. Respondent asserts that the by stipulation of the parties the January 11, 2019 Order of dismissal should state that the matter is dismissed with prejudice.
