Description:	Oakland County, Commerce Township, T02N, R08E, Section 1: A collection of parcels described as Lot Number 163 of Russell Beach Subdivision; Lot 162 of "Russell Beach;" and Lot 114 of Union Lake Highlands, as more accurately described in the case file.
PA 240 of 2018:	The parcels are south of the Mason-Arenac county line and will result in a decrease of 1.72 acres of DNR-managed lands.
Applicant:	Charter Township of Commerce, Oakland County, Michigan
Authority:	Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.
Notice:	This item will appear on the Department of Natural Resources (Department) September 7, 2021, calendar and is eligible for approval on September 14, 2021.
Acquired:	Purchased with Waterways Funds in 1943.
Minerals:	Mineral rights will be conveyed.
Comments:	The desired parcels are the former Union Lake Boating Access Site that is now closed. The Department created a new boating access site further south on Union Lake Road where parking and access ramps are located to the west of the roadway creating much safer conditions.
	The township seeks to purchase the land to keep public access along the shore of Union Lake. The portion of the property located on the east side of Union Lake Road will be used for lane widening along this busy roadway.
	The proposed land disposal was recommended for approval as surplus by the Land Exchange Review Committee on


