2018 – 2019 SCRAP TIRE GRANTS CLEAN-UP, MARKET DEVELOPMENT & LAW ENFORCEMENT

The purpose of this notice is to solicit potential grantees for Michigan DEQ Scrap Tire Grants from eligible organizations to submit applications online through SIGMA Vendor Self Service (VSS). Potential grantees, those registered in VSS, and non-registered guest users, may submit applications in VSS for a published grant opportunity. **To create a grant application please navigate to the VSS website**:

After a VSS account is created, you will be able to check the system for State of Michigan grant opportunities. If you already have a VSS account, no additional action is necessary at this time. DEQ intends for the Scrap Tire grant applications to be available at least one month prior to the application deadline.

Total Amount to be Awarded: A total of \$3,500,000 shared between Clean-up, Market Development and Law Enforcement Grants. Clean-up grants are offered on a first come first serve basis with funding for Market Development and Law Enforcement grants comprising the remainder.

Cost Sharing (Match) Requirements:

- CLEAN-UP GRANTS **NO** match funding requirement.
- MARKET DEVELOPMENT GRANTS Potential grantees are required to provide local matching funds of at least 50% of the total grant budget.

Grant Application Deadlines

Clean-up: August 31, 2018 → now September 28, 2018
 Market Development: September 21, 2018 → now October 19, 2018
 No letter of interest necessary as part of the Market Development Grant application.

• Law Enforcement: September 21, 2018 → now October 19, 2018
