Respondents have admitted that the facts alleged in the Complaint are true and constitute violation(s) of MCL 339.604(c), and Mich Admin Code, R 338.1551(5). The Michigan Board of Residential Builders and Maintenance and Alteration Contractors (Board) has reviewed this Consent Order and Stipulation and agrees that the public interest is best served by resolution of the outstanding Complaint.

Therefore, IT IS FOUND that the facts alleged in the Complaint are true and constitute violation(s) of MCL 339.604(c), and Mich Admin Code, R 338.1551(5).

Forms of acceptable proof of monetary restitution payment include: a copy of the front and back of the cancelled check that was made payable to the person(s) ordered to receive restitution; or a receipt signed by the

person(s) to whom restitution was payable, stating restitution was paid, the amount paid, and the date payment was received.
