All applicants must submit a completed application, pay the required registration fee, and provide documentation supporting the required experience as noted below.

All approved applicants must now pass an examination before the registration will be issued. Passing scores are rated at 75%.

Building Inspector:

 i) A residential builder's license issued by this state and 6 years of experience immediately preceding application in any 1 or more of the following professions: (a) a contractor in general building construction as a contractor (b) a skilled trades worker (c) an individual who was in charge of structural construction.
 ii) A license as a building inspector from other states or foreign countries with inspector experience in building construction. Must provide requirements for licensure prior to approval from department.

iii) Seven years of experience in general building construction in any 1 or more of the following: (a) a building contractor (b) a person in charge of general building construction (c) a project manager, superintendent, supervisor or foreman actively engaged in general building construction immediately preceding submission of application (d) a skilled worker in structural carpentry, structural masonry, structural steel erection, or structural concrete construction who has been actively engaged in the general building construction field immediately preceding application (e) a current license as an architect or engineer under article 20 of the occupational code, 1980 PA 299, MCL 339.2001 to 339.2014.

CONTRACTOR AND GENERAL CONSTRUCTION DOES NOT INCLUDE A PLUMBING, ELECTRICAL OR MECHANICAL CONTRACTOR LICENSE.

Building Plan Reviewer:

i) A residential builder's license issued by this state and 6 years of experience immediately preceding application in any 1 or more of the following professions: (a) general building construction as a contractor (b) skilled trades worker (c) a person in charge of structural construction.

ii) A license as a building plan review from another state or foreign county with plan reviewer experience in building construction. Must provide requirements of licensure before receiving approval from the department.

iii) Seven years experience in general building construction in 1 or more of the following professions: (a)Contractor (b) A skilled trades worker (c) An individual who was a person in charge of structural construction. An individual applying under (iii) must also possess 2 years of experience as a journey level, structural, construction or skilled trades worker including as a carpenter, brick layer or mason, or a steel worker.

Electrical Inspector and Plan Reviewer:

Licensed as an electrical journeyman or master electrician as required under section 1022 of the act, MCL 339.6022.

Mechanical Inspector and Plan Reviewer:

Hold a mechanical license from this state in 3 of the 4 following categories for at least 1 year: (i) Hydronic heating and cooling and process piping; (ii) HVAC equipment; (iii) Refrigeration; (iv) Fire suppression.

If the individual does not hold a mechanical license from this state, shall provide to the department an affidavit of experience from previous and current employers. The affidavit must comply with both of the following: (a) attest that the individual has been actively engaged in the performance of mechanical work in 3 of the 4 categories for 6 years under a licensed mechanical contractor: (i) Hydronic heating and cooling process piping; (ii) HVAC equipment; (iii) Refrigeration; (iv) Fire Suppression. (b) Attest that the licensed mechanical contractor who supervised the applicant was licensed in the required categories at the time of supervision.

Plumbing Inspector and Plan Reviewer:

Hold a journey plumber's license from this state for at least 2 years immediately preceding application; or a current master plumbing license from this state. If the individual does not hold a plumber license from this state, he/she shall provide an affidavit of experience from previous and current employers attesting that he/she was actively engage in the performance of plumbing work for 5 years under a licensed plumbing contractor. If an individual holds a license as a plumbing inspector and/or plumbing plan reviewer for another state or foreign country with inspector and/or plan review experience in plumbing code enforcement, he/she shall provide to the department proof of licensure and the licensing requirements for that state or country to be eligible to receive approval from the department.

Fire Protection System Inspector:

Execute the statement of attestation of understanding of the building code and provide copies of NFPA or ICC Fire Inspector I and II certifications.

Fire Protection System Plan Reviewer:

Execute the statement of attestation of understanding of the building code and provide copies of NFPA or ICC Fire Inspector I and Plan Examiner Certification.

Examination waiver: {IF EXAMINATION IS REQUIRED FOR LICENSURE}

Licensure without examination is possible IF the applicant Provides proof that the applicant is a member of the armed forces or uniformed services, A veteran, or A dependent of a member of the armed forces, a member of the uniformed services, or a veteran AND has an active, valid trade license in at least 1 other state of the United States.
