FINAL ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION FOR LICENSURE

On or about on September 19, 2016, Petitioner filed with the Michigan Board of Residential Builders and Maintenance and Alteration Contractors (Board) an application for licensure to practice as an individual residential builder in the state of Michigan with supporting documents.


On February 1, 2017, the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, Bureau of Professional Licensing (Department), executed a Notice of Denial of Application for Licensure, alleging applicant did not meet one or more of the requirements for licensure pursuant to MCL 339.602(c).

The Board, having reviewed the application, supporting documents, and Petitioner's oral statement, considered this matter at a regularly scheduled meeting held in Lansing, Michigan on December 12, 2017 and recommended that licensure be granted. The Department concurs. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Petitioner's application for licensure to practice as an individual residential builder in the state of Michigan is GRANTED PROVIDED the Department receives satisfactory written evidence that Petitioner meets all requirements for licensure.
