Innovative Best Practices/Safety Initiatives

- 100% fall protection over 6 feet, including steel erection, scaffolds, and roof work.
- Mandatory attendance to a project safety orientation, which includes project orientation, Wolverine Building Group general safety orientation or safety video, passing a written safety test, and signing a safety acknowledgement form.
- All crane operators will be Certified Crane Operators
- A Pre-Task Analysis (PTA) will be completed and submitted to Wolverine Building Group prior to each shift, and prior to the beginning of any critical work.
- Due to the age of the existing building, asbestos and lead are of concern.
 - o If materials are discovered that need to be tested, work will be stopped. Wolverine Building Group will coordinate testing and develop a safe action plan.
