To the Honorable Mike Duggan and Pam Vance:

We hereby give notice pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988, to the extent such law is applicable, of a pending temporary site closure.

This letter is to inform you that The Fillmore Detroit, a venue operated by Live Nation Worldwide, Inc. (the "Company") will be closing temporarily its operations at its location at 2115 Woodward Avenue, Detroit, MI 4820. As of June 4, 2018, operations at this location will be temporarily shut down and active employment at that location will cease until on or about October 2018. Below is a summary of the affected positions and the number of employees holding each position.

Affected employees do not have bumping rights. There is no union representation at this location.

Certain employees may be offered the opportunity to transfer to another area of the Company during the temporary closure. However, at this time, the company does not know which, if any, employees may be offered this option. The venue will be reopening after renovations in or about October 2018 and all of the employees will be eligible for reemployment at that time based on their continued availability.
