You will be provided 5 minutes to make a statement and 10 minutes to take questions from the Commissioners, with your RSVP. A half hour at the end is reserved for a moderated discussion with participants (no RSVP required). At that time, the Townhall will be open for general comments and for participants to comment on suggestions made by other members of the public.
