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# SCHOOL MENTAL HEALTH AND SUPPORT SERVICES GRANT OPPORTUNITY

## FUNDING AVAILABLE FOR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICTS

- ▶ 31n(6), \$16.5 million for School Mental Health and Support Services
- ▶ 31n(10), \$500,000 for program administration
- ▶ 31n(12), \$8 million for Behavioral Health Team Pilot program

## APPLICATION DETAILS

- ▶ Available starting 8:00 a.m. March 1, 2019; closes at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, March 18, 2019

## 31N(6) SCHOOL MENTAL HEALTH AND SUPPORT SERVICES

- ▶ \$16.5M to be equally divided between applying ISDs
- ▶ Applying ISDs agree to:
  - ▶ Submit a plan to provide school mental health and support services to general education students
    - ▶ Further details on required plan components to be released in early April
  - ▶ Provide funding to constituent districts including public school academies and nonpublic students upon request
    - ▶ Local districts and PSAs will apply directly to ISDs

## 31N(10) PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION

- ▶ \$500,000 to be divided equally among applying ISDs
- ▶ To be used for the purpose of administering school mental health and support services

## 31N(12) BEHAVIORAL HEALTH TEAM PILOT PROGRAM

- ▶ \$8 million to be divided equally among applying ISDs
- ▶ Applying ISDs agree to:
  - ▶ Submit an implementation plan outlining how resources will be spent
    - ▶ Details on plan requirements will be released in early April
  - ▶ Create school-based behavioral health assessment teams
  - ▶ Teams will use the “train the trainer” model to:
    - ▶ Focus on age appropriate interventions
    - ▶ Identify behaviors that suggest a student may be struggling with mental health challenges
    - ▶ Provide treatment and support
    - ▶ Use disciplinary interventions as a last resort

## ANTICIPATED TIMELINE

- ▶ March 1, 2019
  - ▶ Application available
- ▶ March 18, 2019
  - ▶ Application due
- ▶ March 29, 2019
  - ▶ Notification of conditional awards
- ▶ Early April, 2019
  - ▶ Awarded ISDs will receive an outline of implementation plan requirements
- ▶ Mid-May, 2019
  - ▶ Implementation plans due
- ▶ Late May, 2019
  - ▶ Plan approval notices released
