**SUBJECT:** CTE Concentrator Definition – 2020-2021

The following definition will be used to determine CTE program concentrators for the 2020-2021 school year.

**<u>Concentrator</u>**: a student who has successfully completed, with a grade of C (2.0) or better, courses totaling **<u>8 to 11 segments</u>** of instruction – regardless of the number of courses taken.

This concentrator definition will be used for **Perkins V** reporting during the <u>2020-2021</u> school year.

The CTE State Aid (Added Cost) Referent Group will convene in Fall 2020 to discuss possible changes that could impact Section 61a(1) funding.
