Each year, Michigan students <u>lose an average of one month's worth of learning over the summer</u>. Therefore, the Michigan Department of Education (MDE), Office of Systems, Evaluation, and Technology (OSET) is pleased to highlight <u>Michigan Virtual's Minecraft Online Summer Camp</u> for grades 3-8. This four-week course is made possible by a partnership between the MDE, OSET and Michigan Virtual. This course supports Michigan's Top 10 in 10 Strategic Plan Goal 2 by enhancing access to effective technology tools that support deeper and personalized learning.

During this four-week online summer camp, students will receive weekly educational challenges and coaching from our Minecraft experts in the colorful and constructible world of Minecraft: Education Edition — the educational version of the award-winning video game sensation. There is a cost of \$49.95. Students will be able to access Minecraft: Education Edition until Labor Day.
