How Michigan Rehabilitation Services can help you

We will offer you choices that may include modifications to tools, equipment or systems, or assistive devices, to allow you to return safely to farming.

We will also provide other services, if needed. These may include:

- Recommendations on how job tasks can be modified.
- Assistance with wheelchairs, hearing aids and other physical restorative devices.
- Assistance with assessments, vocational counseling, or specialized job training, including books, fees and supplies.
- Assistance with medical treatment, therapy or counseling.



Who qualifies for services

Any individual with a disability involved in the agricultural industry can qualify. This includes farmers, family members who work on the farm, farm employees, timbermen, and fishermen.

How MRS partners with easterseals Michigan AgrAbility

Michigan Rehabilitation Services works in partnership with easterseals Michigan AgrAbility to assist farmers with the services they need to continue working.

Services may include:

- Conduct on-site farm evaluations.
- Develop solutions for overcoming barriers.
