

# Michigan Department of Health & Human Services Division of Immunization 2016 Immunization Quality Improvement AFIX Awards



The Michigan AFIX Quality Improvement program is focused on quality improvement of immunizations. The process reviews not only vaccine coverage levels, but also the challenges and barriers occurring at practices. A quality improvement plan is formulated and identifies strategies that can assist the practice with improving vaccinating patients at their offices.

The Local County Health Department Immunization staff conduct annual compliance site visits with provider offices participating in the Vaccine For Children (VFC) program. The visit also includes an AFIX component identifying areas to focus efforts for quality improvement.

The providers who are going to receive Immunization Quality Improvement AFIX Awards during the 2016 Michigan Regional Immunization Conferences are listed on pages 2-4.

There are four categories (2 pediatric and 2 adolescent) for the awards. The providers listed have met or exceeded the category criteria that are listed below. The data was retrieved from the Michigan Care Improvement Registry (MCIR) as of June 2016. Staff from these offices, attending the 2016 conferences, will be given green AFIX Award ribbons to wear on their name tags and the practice/clinic will receive a framed certificate to display in their waiting area. If you are attending one of the conferences and you see someone wearing the green ribbon, please congratulate them and ask them a question about their immunization activities and strategies in their practice that have resulted in high coverage levels.

## **Category 1**

Immunization providers that have pediatric patients (n>10) 24-36 months old with minimum of 90% coverage level for vaccine series: 4:3:1:3:3:1:4:2

## **Category 2**

Immunization providers that have pediatric patients (n>10) 24-36 months old with minimum of 75% coverage level for 2015-2016 seasonal influenza

## **Category 3**

Immunization providers that have adolescent patients (n>10) 13-18 years old with minimum of 90% coverage level for vaccine series: 1:3:2:3:2:1:3 (1Tdap, 3polio, 2MMR, 3HepB, 2varicella, 1MCV, 3HPV)

## **Category 4**

Immunization providers that have adolescent patients (n>10) 13-18 years old with minimum of 75% coverage level for 2015-2016 seasonal influenza
