Themes and Strengths

- Work on focus group development
- Three pieces of this assessment
 - CHA/CHNA—working on report from meta-analysis
 - Web survey—working on social media messages
 - Focus groups—focus on vulnerable populations, facilitators & barriers to health
 - 10 groups in total, 5 by MPHI, 5 by partners (we have \$2000 for each)
 - Mary Grace—NHBS- sample from at risk populations in Wayne, Macomb, Genesee. Employed ethnographers from WSU to recruit at-risk populations. Use existing resource guides to inform their efforts. Hire ethnographers to help with methodological recruitment
 - Brenda—Focus on reaching racial and ethnic populations. NA communities—typically we do not receive a lot of survey data from those groups because of small numbers in state. Have best responses when we collaborate with orgs that have relationships/service to the Native American population (Inter Tribal Council of MI, urban setting organization in Detroit). Asian and Pacific Islander—lower response rate, so may want to think about them too. Latinx population and consider needs for undocumented population.
 - Dawn has a card for Blanca from multicultural center
 - Corktown health center is LGBTQ health provider around Detroit, Jean knows their new program director
 - Have some of these places to promote survey AND focus groups
 - Local Health Departments can help with promoting survey
 - Jean knows someone named Ray Winans who can help with recruitment for formerly incarcerated people
 - MI Coalition for Disability Rights
 - Area Agencies on Aging
 - Southwest Solutions
 - Dale Freeman—migrant workers
 - Lisa Bugg—Asian services
 - Lynn Nee—HIV populations
