An ad hoc Nomination Committee was established to oversee WAMC appointments for the two expiring terms. Members were named by John Weiss, MIC Chairperson, and include Sue McCormick, Dan Fredendall, Dave Wresinski, John Daly III, and Larry Steckelberg.

11. Project Portal Subgroup Update

12. Definitions and Standards Subgroup Update
