

The [MiSSG Student Portal](#) allows students to create an account, complete State financial aid program applications, monitor State financial aid eligibility, and transfer institutions.

For **students** to create an account, they must know their Social Security number (SSN). If the student does not have an SSN, they should contact MI Student Aid at 888-447-2687 for assistance. The MiSSG Student Portal is available at michigan.gov/missg.


Eligibility for State financial aid programs is evaluated based on the first college listed on the FAFSA.

If the student's college choice changes, there are three options to update:

1. Create a [MiSSG Student Portal](#) account and change their institution.
2. Call our Customer Care Center at 1-888-447-2687.
3. Make an update to their FAFSA by logging into fafsa.gov.

How to Update the College on File in the MiSSG Student Portal

1. Log into your MiSSG Student Portal account.


