**Location of Crime**

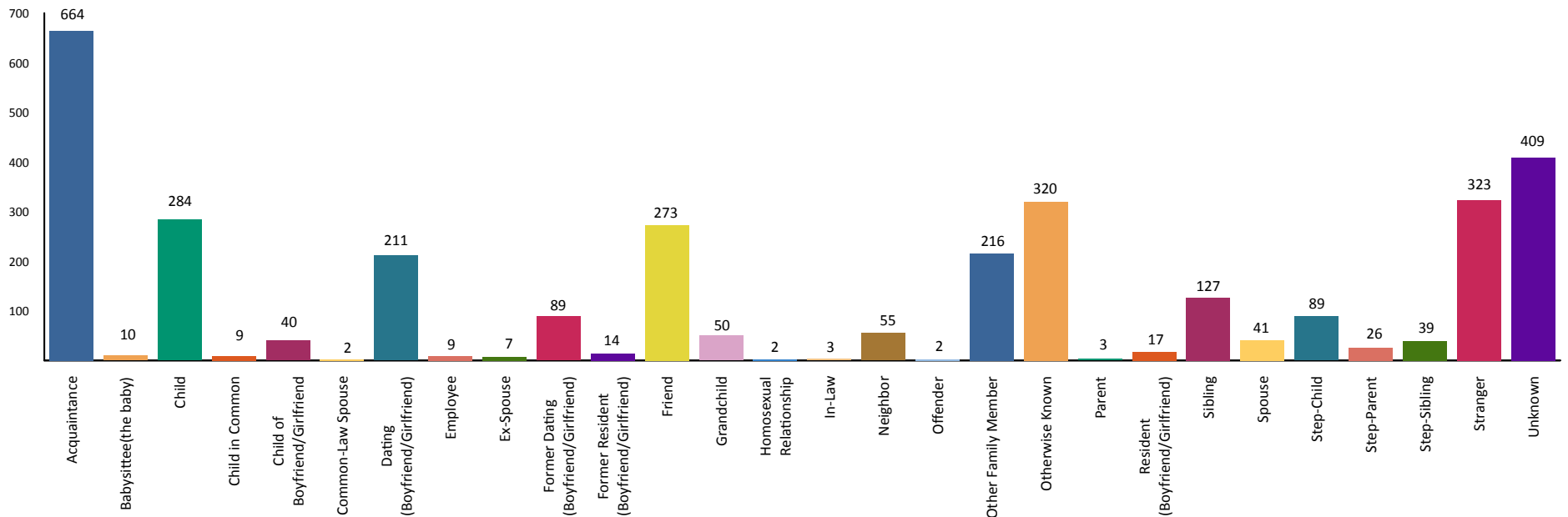

**VOLUME**

The number of victims reported for CSC - 3rd Degree, Sexual Penetration - Penis/Vagina was 1,013. This is a reported decrease of nine percent from 2013.

More victims were reported in the month of October than any other month. The fewest number of victims was reported in December. The most victims were reported on Wednesdays.

**RATE**

The crime rate for this offense in 2014 was 10 for every 100,000 persons, which is a reported decrease of nine percent from 2013.

**CLEARANCES**

Law enforcement agencies cleared 310 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 975 incidents that were reported. This is a reported 32 percent clearance rate.

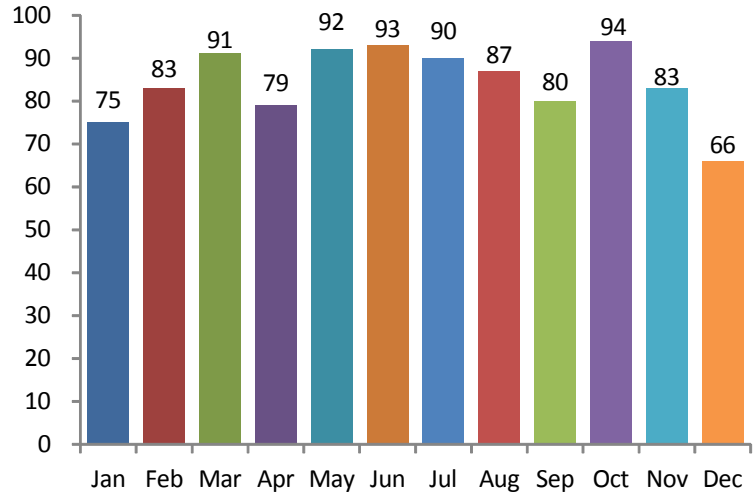

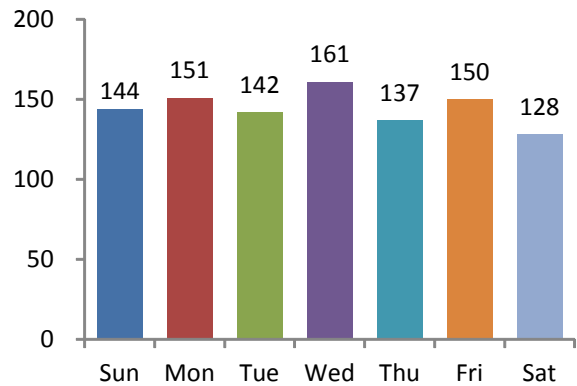

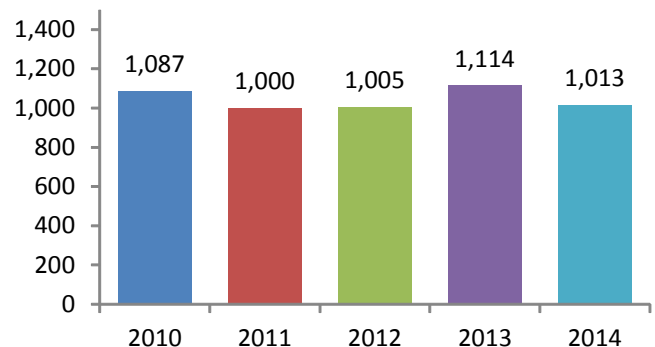
**Victims by Month**



**Victims by Day**

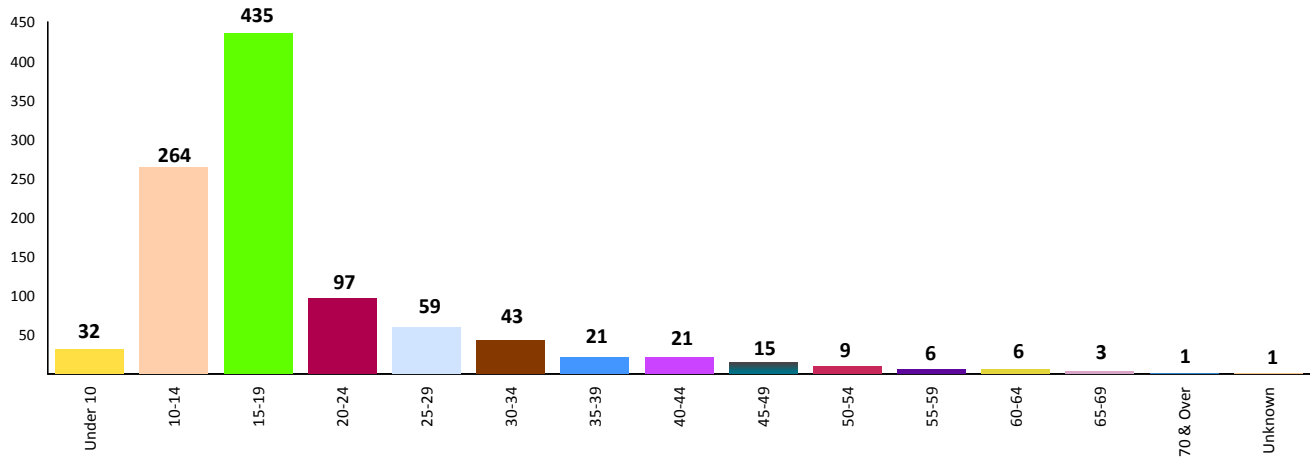

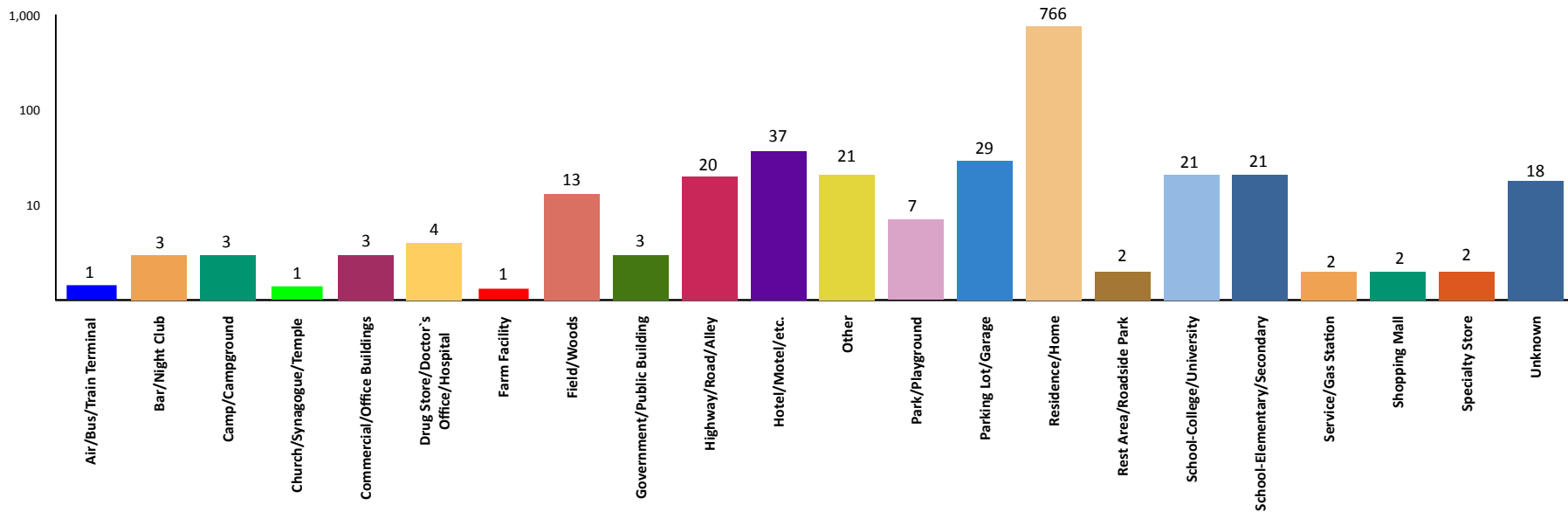




**Victim Injury**

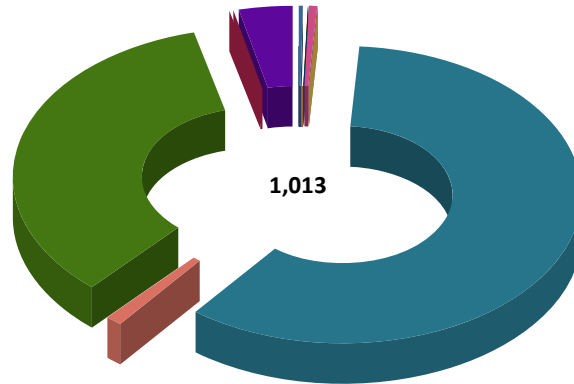

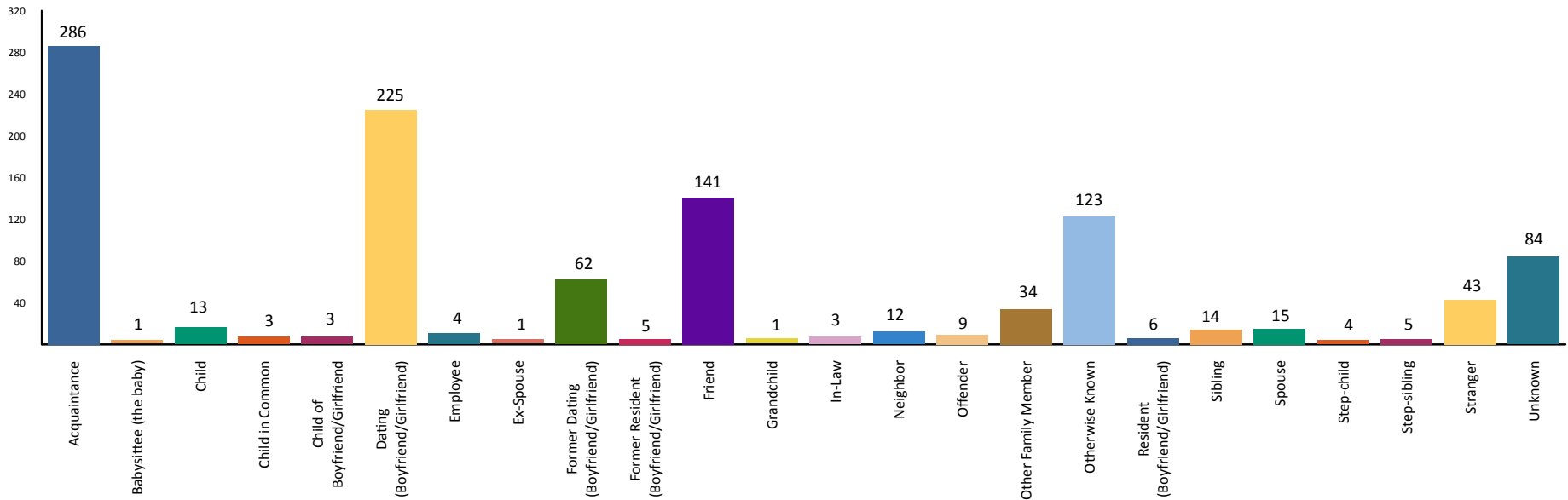

Law enforcement agencies cleared 230 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 911 incidents that were reported. This is a reported 25 percent clearance rate.
