DEFINITION

Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) 1st Degree (MCL 750.520b) is the sexual intercourse of a person, forcibly and/or against that person's will; or, not forcibly or against the person's will where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of his/her temporary or permanent mental or physical incapacity. Michigan collects the crime data for this offense based on the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Incident Based Reporting System (NIBRS).

Note: CSC 1st and 3rd are differentiated by the weapon involved and the degree of the victim injury.

ANALYSIS

VOLUME

The number of victims reported for CSC - 1st Degree, Sexual Penetration - Penis/Vagina was 3,173. This is a reported increase of five percent from 2016 and an eight percent decrease from 2012.

The months of June and July had the most victims reported. The fewest number of victims were reported in December.

RATE

The crime rate for this offense in 2016 was 32 for every 100,000 persons. In 2015, the crime rate was 31 for every 100,000 persons, an increase of three percent.

CLEARANCES

Law enforcement agencies cleared 793 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance. This is a reported twenty-six percent clearance rate.


VICTIM INFORMATION

Seventy-four percent of the victims did not receive any injury. There were seventeen percent of victims who received Apparent Minor injuries and seven percent received Possible Internal injuries.


Thirty-four percent of the victims had a Personal Weapon such as hands, fists, feet, etc., used against them. Fifty-four percent of the victims did not have a weapon used against them.

When reviewing the Victim to Offender relationships, twenty percent of the time the victim was an Acquaintance of the offender. With fourteen percent of the victims, the Victim to Offender relationship was not known to law enforcement, twelve percent were Otherwise Known, and nine percent was reported as a Stranger.


Victims by Month






Weapon Used Against Victim

Michigan collects the crime data for this offense based on the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Incident Based Reporting System (NIBRS).

Note: CSC 1st and 3rd are differentiated by the weapon involved and the degree of the victim injury.

ANALYSIS

VOLUME

The number of victims reported for CSC - 3rd Degree, Sexual Penetration - Penis/Vagina was 1,193. This is a reported increase of five percent from 2015.

More victims were reported in the month of May than any other month. The fewest number of victims were reported in December. The most victims were reported on Tuesdays.

RATE

The crime rate for this offense in 2016 was 12 for every 100,000 persons, which is a reported increase of nine percent from 2015.

CLEARANCES

Law enforcement agencies cleared 333 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 1,152 incidents that were reported. This is a reported twenty-nine percent clearance rate.

Law enforcement agencies cleared 258 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 1,029 incidents that were reported. This is a reported twenty-five percent clearance rate.

More victims were reported in the month of March than any other month. The fewest number of victims were reported in November. These crimes occurred most often on Fridays.

RATE

The crime rate for this offense in 2016 was five for every 100,000 persons, which is the same as what was reported in 2015.

CLEARANCES

Law enforcement agencies cleared 119 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 416 incidents that were reported. This is a reported twenty-nine percent clearance rate.


Location of Crime




