



# SOS-437 Farm Plate Certification

## Introduction

[MCL 257.801(1)(c)] [MCL 257.802(10)]

The Michigan Vehicle Code prescribes the issuance and use of farm plates. Farm plates have certain restrictions. A vehicle qualifies for this reduced rate license plate when it meets all of these conditions:

- The vehicle must be a road tractor, modified agricultural vehicle, truck, or truck tractor.
- The vehicle must be owned by a farmer which may be an individual, company, or corporation.
- The vehicle must be used exclusively for a farming operation. The vehicle may operate on farms not owned by the farmer, and the farmer may receive compensation of any type except money. Alternatively, it may be used to transport the farmer and the farmer's family, as long as it is not used for hire.
