- This form cannot be used to apply for an instant title unless the agent is a vehicle dealer licensed in Michigan.
- This form cannot be used to appoint a single individual to sign as both a seller and a buyer of a vehicle that requires odometer disclosure under MCL 257.233a.
- A false statement in connection with a title transaction is a crime.
