

VOTING OPTIONS

Register



- ➔ **Recommended:** Register by mail/online at Michigan.gov/Vote through July 20.
- ➔ Register in person at your local clerk's office up to and on Election Day and vote while there. Visit Michigan.gov/Vote for clerk information.

Request to have a ballot mailed to you



- ➔ Apply online or download an application at Michigan.gov/Vote. Accessible applications are also available. If you download, sign the application and then email or mail it to your local clerk.
- ➔ **Recommended:** Apply by July 21.

Vote early or on Election Day



- ➔ **Early:** Ballots mailed to your home must be received by your clerk by 8 p.m. Election Day. SIGN THE BACK OF THE ENVELOPE and return them:
 - By dropping off at your clerk office or a ballot dropbox; or
 - By mailing your ballot (recommended by July 21).
- ➔ **Early:** Visit your local clerk's office through Aug. 3.
- ➔ **Election Day:** Go to your polling place or, if not yet registered, your clerk's office. Find both at Michigan.gov/Vote.
- ➔ **Note:** Clerk's offices and polling places will be supplied with protective and hygiene equipment, and will follow protocols to ensure safe in-person voting.
