New Report

- In collaboration with MDE and EPIC at Michigan State University, CEPI will release the new **Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan Dashboard** showing what methods of instruction districts are planning to provide to students during the pandemic. This first dashboard report reflects survey results as of Friday, November 6, prior to the Nov. 15, 2020 emergency epidemic order issued by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services. It displays a breakdown of district plans to provide fully in-person, fully in-person with a remote option, fully remote, or a hybrid of in-person and remote instruction. Districts report data through a monthly survey and the dashboard is expected to be updated with point-in-time information that is subject to change as the pandemic necessitates. While plans do not necessarily completely align with the realities of education delivery during the pandemic, they are intended to showcase approved local board decisions about the delivery model on a monthly basis.

Coming Soon

- Due to COVID-19, the United States Department of Education waived many, but not all, of the required data elements for the 2020-21 [Annual Education Report](#). This year's report will display detailed information on high school graduation data, teacher quality, National Assessment of Educational Progress, and Section 1003 School Improvement funds for schools, districts, and the state. Data will be released in preview and be publicly available after two weeks.
