

Trinity Response to Question regarding Catholic Chapel:

While there are no specific provisions in the Asset Purchase Agreement regarding the use of the chapel, Trinity Health has received appropriate approvals, consistent with Catholic Church requirements and protocols, from the Archdiocese of Detroit and the Vatican to alienate (convey) the SJMPH properties to Prime.

Prime has informed Trinity Health that the chapel will transition to an interfaith chapel and be maintained as such (Prime has informed Trinity that a Catholic priest can still utilize the chapel to conduct mass). Additionally, Prime has informed Trinity that it will continue to allow access to all who desire to utilize it in their time of need (regardless of faith).

With this transition to an interfaith chapel, the tabernacle and other Catholic artifacts in the chapel will be removed consistent with Section 2.4(h) in the Asset Purchase Agreement and returned either to the original donors, the family members of the original donors or retained by the Archdiocese of Detroit.
