Court of Claims Notice of Intent No. 24-200183-0

Dear Senators, Representatives, and Directors:

MCL 18.1396 directs the Attorney General to notify you in the event of a settlement or consent judgment in excess of \$200,000.00. Accordingly, I am notifying you that the Michigan Department of State (MDOS) settled the abovereferenced matter for \$775,000.00.

This matter involved a Department Bureau Director, who filed a notice of intent to sue with the Court of Claims alleging disparate treatment, retaliation, and hostile work environment based on her race, gender, and having engaged in protected activity in violation of the Elliott Larsen Civil Rights Act. While MDOS disputed these claims, to avoid protracted litigation and the risks and costs such litigation brings, the parties negotiated a separation agreement.

Had this matter proceeded to a trial damages and attorney fees considerably in excess of the settlement amount were possible.
