**RE: 2025 PA 22 – WICA Quarterly Report – 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of FY 2026**

Dear Representatives, Senators, and Directors;

Pursuant to 2025 PA 22, the Department is directed to provide a quarterly report on the wrongful imprisonment compensation fund. The specific report language and the department's responses for the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of the Fiscal Year 2026 (October 1, 2025 – December 31, 2025) are as follows:

- (a) All payments made from the wrongful imprisonment fund in each prior quarter of the fiscal year, and the total of those payments, including if each payment is part of a new settlement or part of an installment plan.

**TOTAL PAYMENTS OUT OF THE FUND: \$2,990,859.82**

1. *Kenneth Milton v State of Michigan*, Court of Claims No. 24-000180-MZ. On October 13, 2025, the Court signed an Order of Judgement, awarding Milton with \$1,954,162.35 in WICA relief. An order awarding attorney fees and costs was entered providing for the payment of attorney fees in the amount of \$16,867.25 and costs of \$354.94.
2. *Erone Shelman v State of Michigan*, Court of Claims No. 25-000004-MZ. On October 24, 2025, the parties signed a Release and Settlement Agreement awarding Shelman \$1,004,228.03 in WICA relief. The agreement also awarded \$15,000 in attorneys' fees and \$247.25 in costs.
