ORDER AUTHORIZING ISSUANCE OF CIVIL INVESTIGATIVE SUBPOENAS

The Attorney General has presented this Court with an *Ex Parte* Petition for Civil Investigative Subpoenas related to an investigation of Respondent Michigan's Choice Tree Service, LLC. Through the *Ex Parte* Petition, the Attorney General alleges that there is probable cause to believe respondent has violated the Michigan Consumer Protection Act (the Act), MCL 445.901 *et seq.*

Having had an opportunity to review these materials, this Court finds that probable cause exists to believe respondent has violated the Act.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Attorney General, acting through her assistants, is authorized to issue investigative subpoenas to Respondent, and to current and former employees for Respondent.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Attorney General, acting through her assistants, is authorized to issue additional subpoenas seeking testimony and documentation from persons and entities having relevant information that are identified during the course of this investigation.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
