**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S REQUEST FOR A PRELIMINARY
INJUNCTION ENJOINING DEFENDANTS FROM OPERATING
UNLICENSED ADULT FOSTER CARE FACILITIES IN VIOLATION
OF MCL 400.701 AT ANY LOCATION WITHIN THE STATE OF MICHIGAN**

This matter comes before the Court upon Plaintiff's Complaint for Preliminary and Permanent Injunctive Relief seeking to preliminarily and permanently enjoin Defendants from operating an unlicensed adult foster care facility in violation of the Adult Foster Care Facility Licensing Act, 1979 PA 218, MCL 400.701 *et seq.* After a show cause hearing being held on November 29, 2023, the Court found that a preliminary injunction should be issued, now therefore:

IT IS ORDERED that Defendants Erica Edwards and ETE Homes Inc. d/b/a Talison Assisted Living are subject to the requirements of the Adult Foster Care Facility Act, MCL 400.701 *et seq.*

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that for the reasons stated on the record, Defendants as well as any of Defendants' employees, agents, representatives, assigns, or those acting in concert with Defendants are preliminarily enjoined from operating an adult foster care facility and providing adult foster care at 30114 Ardmore Drive in Farmington Hills, Michigan, or any other location within the State of Michigan without an adult foster care license.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants and their employees will cooperate with Michigan Department of Health and Human Services Adult Protective Services workers, Adult Foster Care Licensing workers, Community Mental Health workers, and law enforcement to assess and remove, if necessary, any residents, who reside at 30114 Ardmore Drive in Farmington Hills, Michigan where Defendants are operating or providing adult foster care services and who are in need of adult foster care services, as the term is defined by MCL 400.701 *et seq.*


Defendants will allow the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services Adult Protective Services workers, Adult Foster Care Licensing workers, and Community Mental Health workers to gain access to the premises and the residents. Law enforcement and medical personnel may accompany any of the above-mentioned workers, if necessary.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a hearing will be scheduled within six (6) months of the date of this order issuing a preliminary injunction to determine whether a permanent injunction should be issued.

This is not a final order that closes the case.
