ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS CASE

On February 6, 2024, the Court issued its oral ruling regarding Michigan Environmental Agencies' Objection to the Proposed Plan and Motion to Dismiss ("Dismissal Motion").¹ The Dismissal Motion was filed on behalf of creditors Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy and the Michigan Department of Natural Resources (collectively "Michigan Environmental Agencies").

At the February 6, 2024 oral ruling, attorney Nathan A. Gambill appeared telephonically on behalf of the Michigan Environmental Agencies. Attorney Troy S. Fox appeared telephonically on behalf of Lee Worthington Mueller ("Debtor"). No other telephonic appearances were noted on the record.

7 bankruptcy case is **DISMISSED**.

8 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Objection to the Proposed Plan is **DENIED** as
