Sec. xxx. (1) The department of natural resources shall enter into agreements with local units of government to administer the grants identified in part 1. Among other provisions, the agreements must require that grant recipients agree to dedicate to public outdoor recreation uses in perpetuity the land acquired or developed; to replace lands converted or lost to other than public outdoor recreation use; and, for parcels acquired that are larger than 5 acres, to provide this state with a nonparticipating 1/6 minimum royalty interest in any acquired minerals that are retained by the grant recipient.

(2) The agreements under subsection (1) must also provide that the full payments of grants be made only after proof of acquisition, or proof of completion of the development project, is submitted by the grant recipient and all costs are verified by the department of natural resources. This requirement may be waived by the department of natural resources.

Sec. xxx. The appropriations in part 1 for capital outlay shall be carried forward at the end of the fiscal year consistent with the provisions of section 248 of the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1248.

#### **Explanation**

This supplemental recommends a total of \$45.6 million from the Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund (MNRTF). Overall, this request includes 117 land acquisition and development recreation projects supported with revenue from the MNRTF and reflects those projects recommended by the MNRTF Board on December 1, 2021. The MNRTF provides financial assistance to local units of government and the Department of Natural Resources to purchase land for public outdoor recreation and the protection of natural resources and open space, as well as to develop land for public outdoor recreation.
