Recently Released to the Public

2021-22

- [Award After Postsecondary CTE Completion](#) shows counts and percentages of postsecondary CTE completers who went on to earn postsecondary awards.
- [Entry Level Wages Over Time](#) shows the trend of annual wages for students one year after completing their highest level of education, grouped by level of education completed.
- [High School CTE Status by Educational Attainment](#) shows counts and percentages of highest level of education achieved, grouped based on high school CTE status.
- [High School CTE Status of Postsecondary CTE Completers](#) shows statewide counts and percentages of students who have earned a CTE postsecondary award and participated in high school CTE.
- [Median Annual Wages by Educational Attainment](#) shows annual wages for students one and five years after completing their highest level of education.
- [Median Annual Wages by Educational Attainment and High School CTE Status](#) compares students' wages one year after completing their highest level of education, grouped by high school CTE status and educational attainment.
- [Median Annual Wages by Field of Study](#) compares the annual wages of students who earned a postsecondary degree or certificate in a field of study one and five years after graduation. Comparisons can also be made between different fields of study.
- [Postsecondary CTE Awards by High School CTE Status](#) compares counts and percentages of how many high school graduates earned a postsecondary

CTE award, based on high school CTE participation.

- The [Student Growth](#) report shows changes in scores for students who have taken two or more consecutive state assessment tests in Michigan. Student growth is represented by the Student Growth Percentile, which groups students with similar score histories and compares their most recent performance.
- The [School Grades](#) report is based on the [Michigan School Grades System](#). Schools receive up to five letter grades and three ranking labels for various performance components.
- The **School Services and Offerings** section of the [Parent Dashboard](#) contains information on schools' programs and services such as extracurricular activities, electives, support services and more. The data have been updated with information from the MSDS and the Points of Pride section of the EEM as of July 1, 2022. This update also features a new user-friendly, universal display that displays the full set of available values for each metric.

Recently Released in Preview

2021-22

- The [Annual Education Report](#) displays detailed information on student assessment, accountability, educator qualifications, National Assessment of Educational Progress, and Section 1003 School Improvement funds for schools, districts, and the state. Data will be publicly released this week.

Coming Soon

2021-22

- Data showing the number and percent of 3rd, 8th and 11th grade students who were proficient on the M-STEP, PSAT and SAT and were identified as "Section 31a At Risk" will be updated in the [At Risk Student](#) report.
- The [CTE Programs Offered](#) report contains an interactive map showing the locations of Career and Technical Education programs offered in Michigan. Users can search for CTE programs by location or by specific CTE program.
- The [Early Childhood Program Participation](#) report shows the number of children enrolled in select early childhood programs prior to kindergarten.
- Financial information reports include district and statewide [expenditure](#), [revenue](#), [fund balance](#) and [balance sheet](#) data. Additionally, the [District Financial Transparency Dashboard](#) provides a comprehensive view of district

finances, including up to five years of trend information.

- The [School-Level Expenditure Report](#) breaks down expenditures of federal, state and local funds for public schools. Users can compare expenditures at county, city, ISD, district or school levels.
- The [Top 30/Bottom 30 Analysis](#) report shows information on students who score in the top 30%, middle 40% and bottom 30% on state tests. The data are broken out into multiple subgroups including race/ethnicity, gender, grade, and program participation, which identifies if a student is economically disadvantaged, an English learner, homeless, or disabled.
- The following items on the [English Learner Dashboard](#) will be updated:
 - The **English Learners Exited from English Learner Services** metric shows how many students exited from EL services during the most recent school year.
 - The **Former English Learner Students** metric shows a cumulative count of all students at the selected location who exited from EL services since 2011-12.
 - **Length of Time Receiving English Learner Services** shows the median number of years students were enrolled in EL services before exiting. This metric is also on the [Parent Dashboard](#) and will be updated there.

2022-23

- The **Qualified Teaching Staff** metric on the [Parent Dashboard](#) shows the percentage of teachers, by content area, who are certified to teach the assignment they are teaching.
