- [Award After Postsecondary CTE Completion](#) shows counts and percentages of postsecondary Career and Technical Education completers who went on to earn postsecondary awards.
- [Entry Level Wages Over Time](#) shows the trend of annual wages for students one year after completing their highest level of education, grouped by level of education completed. This report has also been updated with new report settings that allow users to filter data by location, workforce industry, age band, ethnicity and gender.
- [High School CTE Status by Educational Attainment](#) shows counts and percentages of highest level of education achieved, grouped by high school CTE status.
- [High School CTE Status of Postsecondary CTE Completers](#) shows statewide counts and percentages of students who have earned a CTE postsecondary award and participated in high school CTE.
- [Median Annual Wages by Educational Attainment](#) shows annual wages for students one and five years after completing their highest level of education. This report has also been updated with new report settings that allow users to filter data by location, age band, ethnicity and gender.
- [Median Annual Wages by Educational Attainment and High School CTE Status](#) compares students' wages one year after completing their highest level of education, grouped by high school CTE status and educational attainment. This report has also been updated with new report settings that allow users to filter data by location, workforce industry, CTE program concentration, age band, ethnicity and gender.

- [Median Annual Wages by Field of Study](#) compares the annual wages of students who earned a postsecondary degree or certificate one and five years after graduation, grouped by field of study. Comparisons can also be made between different fields of study. This report has also been updated with new report settings that allow users to filter data by location, age band, ethnicity and gender.
- The [Michigan's Education Staff](#) Education Focus Area provides state- and district-level data on staff and student demographics, teacher and support staff retention, student/staff ratios, and support staff assignments.
- [Postsecondary CTE Awards by High School CTE Status](#) compares counts and percentages of high school graduates who earned a postsecondary CTE award, based on high school CTE participation.
- The [School Index](#) report displays school accountability measures as an index value from 0-100. Accountability targets include assessment performance, assessment participation, student growth, graduation rates, attendance rates and postsecondary enrollment. Schools receive an overall index as well as index values for individual targets. The [MDE Michigan School Index resources web page](#) contains more information on the index system.

- The [Annual Education Report](#) displays detailed information on student assessment, accountability, educator qualifications, and other educational information for schools, districts, and the state.
- The [Early Childhood Program Participation](#) report shows the number of children enrolled in certain early childhood programs prior to kindergarten.
- The [School Grades](#) report is based on the Michigan School Grades System. Schools receive up to five letter grades and three ranking labels for various performance components.
- The following metrics on the [English Learner Dashboard](#) will be updated:
 - **English Learners Exited from English Learner Services** shows how many students exited from EL services during the most recent school year.
 - **Former English Learner Students** shows a cumulative count of all students at the selected location who exited from EL services since 2011-12.
 - **Length of Time Receiving English Learner Services** shows the median number of years students were enrolled in EL services before

exiting. This metric is also on the [Parent Dashboard](#).

- The following data on the [Parent Dashboard](#) will be updated:
 - **Length of Time Receiving English Learner Services** shows the median number of years students were enrolled in EL services before exiting. This metric is also on the [English Learner Dashboard](#).
 - **Similar School Averages**, also known as **Peer Data**, provide data for each metric from up to 30 schools that are geographically nearby or possess similar characteristics to the selected location. Similar characteristics include the number of enrolled students, student-teacher ratio, percentage of students eligible for free or reduced-price lunch, and funding spent per student. Because averages are based on the most recent year, data for all years and metrics will be updated.
