Released to the Public

2022-23

- The [District Financial Transparency Dashboard](#) provides an overview of district finances, including up to five years of trend information.
- The following data on the [Parent Dashboard](#) have been updated:
 - The **Enrolling and Passing Coursework** metric shows the percent of students who enrolled in and passed advanced courses including Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, Career and Technical Education, Early Middle College and Dual Enrollment classes. The **Advanced Coursework** metric on the Parent Dashboard Overview contains the same data and has also been updated.
 - **On-Track Attendance** shows the percent of students who miss fewer than 10% of possible attendance days.
 - **Similar School Averages**, also known as **Peer Data**, provide comparison data from up to 30 schools that are geographically nearby or possess similar characteristics to the selected location. Similar characteristics include the number of enrolled students, student-teacher ratio, percentage of students eligible for free or reduced-price lunch, and funding spent per student. Because averages are based on the most recent year, data for all years and metrics are updated.

- The [Quick Facts](#) report provides an overview of the types and counts of education buildings in a selected location. Data can be viewed by state, ISD

and district.

- Counts and percentages of students who were enrolled in the same grade level for two consecutive years are shown in the [Retained in Grade](#) report.
- The [Schools of Choice and Other Non-Resident Enrollments](#) report displays counts and percentages of students enrolled in a school outside of the district where they live.
- **School Services and Offerings** on the [Parent Dashboard](#) contains information on schools' select programs and services such as extracurricular activities, electives, support services and more. The data will be updated with information from the MSDS and the Points of Pride section of the EEM as of Dec. 4, 2023.
- The [Student Enrollment Counts](#) report provides the unduplicated count and composition of students attending a specific Michigan district or school. This report will be released in preview this week.

Fall 2023

- The number of Michigan public high school graduates who enrolled in a college or university within 48 months of high school graduation is shown in the [College Enrollment by High School](#) report.
- The [College Enrollment Destination](#) report shows which colleges and universities Michigan public high school students enrolled in within 48 months of high school graduation by school or district, and by graduation year.
- The [Postsecondary Student Data File](#) lets users with secure access view student-level information on college enrollment, coursework, cumulative credits, program and award information, and GPAs for students from in-state and out-of-state colleges and universities.

2022-23

- The percent of public high school students who graduated or dropped out is shown in the [Graduation/Dropout Rate](#) report. Users can view four-, five- and six-year rates as well as data for different student subgroups and demographics for a selected school year.
