- [Postsecondary: Progress Toward Sixty by 30](#) explores postsecondary enrollment, persistence and completion rates for Michigan students. The report tracks progress toward Michigan's initiative to increase the percentage of adults with postsecondary degrees or certificates to 60% by 2030.
- The Postsecondary [Success Rates](#) report shows the number of degree-seeking students achieving successful outcomes at Michigan's public universities and community colleges. This update includes the addition of data for some 4-year independent colleges, starting with students enrolling in the 2018-19 school year. Types of successes being recognized include earning a certificate, associate, or bachelor's degree or transferring from a community college to a 4-year institution as a degree-seeking student.
