Released to the Public

2022-23

- Data showing the revenue a selected district receives from the state per enrolled student have been updated on the [Foundation Allowance](#) report.

2021-22

- The [School-Level Expenditure Report](#) breaks down expenditures of federal, state and local funds for public schools. Users can compare expenditures at county, city, ISD, district or school levels.

2022-23

- The **Qualified Teaching Staff** metric on the [Parent Dashboard](#) shows the percentage of teachers, by content area, who are certified in the assignment they are teaching.

2021-22

- [Postsecondary: Progress Toward Sixty by 30](#) uses data from CEPI and other sources to explore postsecondary enrollment, persistence and completion rates for Michigan students. The report tracks progress toward Michigan's initiative to increase the percentage of adults with postsecondary degrees or certificates to 60% by 2030.
- The Postsecondary [Success Rates](#) report shows the number of degree-seeking students achieving successful outcomes at Michigan's public universities and community colleges. Some 4-year Independent colleges will also now be included, starting with students enrolling in the 2018-19 school year. Successes include earning a certificate, associate, or bachelor's degree at a public university or community college or transferring from a community

college to a 4-year institution as a degree-seeking student. These rates capture both part- and full-time enrollment, as well as mobility between institutions.
