- Postsecondary: Progress Toward Sixty by 30 uses data from CEPI and other sources to explore postsecondary enrollment, persistence and completion rates for Michigan students. The report tracks progress on Michigan's initiative to increase the percentage of adults with postsecondary degrees or certificates to 60% by 2030.
- School Services and Offerings on the <u>Parent Dashboard</u> contains information on schools' select programs and services such as extracurricular activities, electives, support services and more. The data will be updated with information from the MSDS and the Points of Pride section of the EEM as of April 12, 2024.
- The <u>Special Education Dashboard</u> of contains key metrics about students with disabilities in Michigan public schools. The report shows four topic areas: student count (including graduation/dropout data), performance on target indicators used in annual public reporting, counts of students by disabilities, and proficiency on the M-STEP or PSAT in English (ELA/EBRW) and math.
