#### Released to the Public

#### 2022-23

The <u>Postsecondary Success Rates</u> report shows the number of degree-seeking students achieving successful outcomes at Michigan's public universities and community colleges. Successes include earning a certificate, associate, or bachelor's degree at a public university or community college or transferring from a community college to a 4-year institution as a degree-seeking student. These rates capture both part- and full-time enrollment, as well as mobility between institutions.

#### 2023-24

- The following items on the <u>Parent Dashboard</u> have been updated:
- The **Qualified Teaching Staff** metric shows the percentage of teachers, by content area, who are certified in the assignment they are teaching.
- The Student Characteristics page provides a detailed breakdown of a school's student population by ethnicity, gender, English Learners, students with disabilities, and economically disadvantaged status. The page also shows average percentages for similar schools and statewide.
