Users can download data for these reports using the Indicator data files **with Part B (Special Education)**. *Early On*® data are available using the **Part C (Early On**®) downloadable file. During the preview period, secure users can navigate to the report under K-12 Grade > Special Education > New Annual Public Reporting. The report will be publicly available on May 26, 2023.

- The [Postsecondary Student Data File](#) allows users with secure access to view student-level information on college enrollment, coursework, cumulative credits, program and award information, and GPAs for students from in-state and out-of-state colleges and universities.

2021-22

- The [School-Level Expenditure Report](#) breaks down expenditures of federal, state and local funds for public schools. Users can compare expenditures at county, city, ISD, district or school levels.

- The **Total School Expenditures Per-Pupil** metric on the [Parent Dashboard](#) shows the amount of money a district spent on education in a school, divided by the number of students educated in that school.
