Released to the Public

2022-23

- Data showing attendance rates for all students and the chronically absent and not chronically absent subgroups are shown in the [Student Attendance](#) report.
- The **Student Attendance** metric on the [Parent Dashboard](#) shows a school's attendance rates compared to the average attendance rates for similar schools and statewide.
- The [Top 30/Bottom 30 Analysis](#) report shows information on students who score in the top 30%, middle 40% and bottom 30% on state tests. The data are broken out into subgroups including race/ethnicity, gender, grade and program participation, which identifies if a student is economically disadvantaged, an English learner, homeless or disabled.

- Data showing the number and percent of "Section 31a At Risk" 3rd, 8th and 11th grade students who were proficient on the M-STEP, PSAT and SAT will be updated in the [At Risk Student](#) report. Data will be publicly available within a week.

- The **Teacher Retention** metric on the [Parent Dashboard](#) displays how many teachers are retained year over year at the same school.

2022-23

- [**Award After Postsecondary CTE Completion**](#) shows counts and percentages of postsecondary CTE completers who went on to earn postsecondary awards.
- The [**English Learner Student Growth**](#) report shows how much growth English learner students made in learning the English language in comparison to their EL peers, as measured across two consecutive years of the WIDA ACCESS for ELLs.
- [**Entry Level Wages Over Time**](#) shows the trend of annual wages for students one year after completing their highest level of education, grouped by level of education completed.
- [**High School CTE Status by Educational Attainment**](#) shows counts and percentages of highest level of education achieved, grouped based on high school CTE status.
- [**High School CTE Status of Postsecondary CTE Completers**](#) shows statewide counts and percentages of students who have earned a CTE postsecondary award and participated in high school CTE.
- [**Median Annual Wages by Educational Attainment**](#) shows annual wages for students one and five years after completing their highest level of education.
- [**Median Annual Wages by Educational Attainment and High School CTE Status**](#) compares students' wages one year after completing their highest level of education, grouped by high school CTE status and educational attainment.
- [**Median Annual Wages by Field of Study**](#) compares the annual wages of students who earned a postsecondary degree or certificate one and five years after graduation, grouped by field of study. Comparisons can also be made between different fields of study.
- [**Postsecondary CTE Awards by High School CTE Status**](#) compares counts and percentages of high school graduates who earned a postsecondary CTE award, based on high school CTE participation.
- The [**Student Growth**](#) report shows changes in scores for students who have taken two or more consecutive state assessment tests in Michigan. Student growth is represented by the Student Growth Percentile, which groups students with similar score histories and compares their most recent performance.

- Head Start, GSRP and GSRP/Head Start Blend providers with secure accounts can use the [Third Grade Assessment Outcomes for Early Childhood Participants](#) report to see how students who were previously enrolled in their programs performed on third grade M-STEP assessments.
- The **Teacher Years of Experience** metric on the [Parent Dashboard](#) shows the median years of Michigan teaching experience for teachers.
- The following items on the [English Learner Dashboard](#) will be updated:
 - The **English Learners Exited from English Learner Services** metric shows how many students exited from EL services during the most recent school year.
 - The **Former English Learner Students** metric shows a cumulative count of students at the selected location who exited from EL services since 2011-12.
 - **Length of Time Receiving English Learner Services** shows the median number of years students were enrolled in EL services before exiting. This metric is also on the [Parent Dashboard](#) and will be updated there as well.
