Released to the Public

2022-23

- The **Continuity of Service in Special Education** reports show early intervention and special education services delivered to Michigan children during three important age spans: birth to third birthday, third birthday to kindergarten entry, and kindergarten to 3rd grade.
 - The [Service Comparisons](#) report shows the percentage of students receiving services in each age group for a selected ISD compared to the statewide percentage.
 - The [Service Pathways](#) report shows the number and percentage of children receiving services in each age group, as well as when children began and finished receiving services.
- The [K-3 Absenteeism and Early Childhood Participation](#) report shows attendance rates of K-3 students who participated in certain early childhood programs before entering kindergarten, such as GSRP, GSRP/Head Start Blend, Head Start, Early Head Start, Early Childhood Special Education or *Early On*®.
- The following items on the [Parent Dashboard](#) have been updated:
 - **English Learner Participation** shows whether at least 95% of English learner students took the WIDA test.
 - The **English Learner Progress** metric shows the percent of EL students who, based on improvement in their WIDA test scores, are on track to being proficient in English within three years.
 - **Progress** shows the percent of students on track to becoming proficient on the SAT, PSAT, M-STEP and/or MI-Access state tests, or who are already proficient and continue to improve their scores.
 - **School Services and Offerings** contains information on school programs and services such as extracurricular activities, electives, support services and more. The data have been updated with

information from MSDS and the Points of Pride section of EEM as of June 30, 2023.

- The **Student Transfers** metric shows the rate of student movement out of a school during a school year (number of student withdrawals divided by the total enrollment at the beginning of the school year).
- **Test Participation** shows whether at least 95% of enrolled students took state tests in all subjects.

- Data showing the number and percent of “Section 31a At Risk” 3rd, 8th and 11th grade students who were proficient on the M-STEP, PSAT and SAT will be updated in the [At Risk Student](#) report.
- The [Student Growth](#) report shows changes in scores for students who have taken two or more consecutive state assessment tests in Michigan. Student growth is represented by the Student Growth Percentile, which groups students with similar score histories and compares their most recent performance.
- The [Top 30/Bottom 30 Analysis](#) report shows information on students who score in the top 30%, middle 40% and bottom 30% on state tests. The data are broken out into multiple subgroups including race/ethnicity, gender, grade and program participation, which identifies if a student is economically disadvantaged, an English learner, homeless or disabled.
