Recently Released to the Public

2021-22

- Attendance rates of K-3 students who participated in certain early childhood programs before entering kindergarten, such as GSRP, GSRP/Head Start Blend, Head Start, Early Head Start, Early Childhood Special Education, or *Early On*®, are shown in the [K-3 Absenteeism and Early Childhood Participation](#) report.

- Data showing how school districts rated the effectiveness of their teachers and administrators will be updated in the [Educator Effectiveness](#) report. Data will be publicly available within a week.

Recently Released to Secure Users

2021-22

- Users with secure access can compare student achievement on state standardized tests for a variety of subgroups in the [Achievement Gap](#) report.
- The [Special Education Dashboard](#) contains key metrics about students with disabilities in Michigan public schools. The report shows four topic areas: student count (including graduation/dropout data), performance on target indicators used in annual public reporting, counts of students by disabilities, and proficiency on the M-STEP or PSAT in English (ELA/EBRW) and math. This report is only available to secure users.

Coming Soon

2021-22

- The [School Index](#) report displays school accountability measures as an index value from 0-100. Index numbers are calculated based on how well the selected

school met targets in areas including assessment performance, assessment participation, student growth, graduation rates, attendance rates and postsecondary enrollment. Schools receive an overall index as well as index values for the individual components.

- The **School Services and Offerings** section of the [Parent Dashboard](#) contains information on schools' select programs and services such as extracurricular activities, electives, support services and more. The data will be updated with information from the MSDS and the Points of Pride section of the Educational Entity Master as of July 1, 2022. This update will also feature a new user-friendly, universal display that displays the full set of available values for each metric.

2019-20 and 2020-21

- The **Enrolling and Passing Coursework** metric on the [Parent Dashboard](#) shows the percent of students who enrolled in and passed advanced courses including Advanced Placement classes, International Baccalaureate courses, Career and Technical Education programs, Early Middle College classes, and Dual Enrollment classes. The **Advanced Coursework** metric on the Parent Dashboard Overview contains the same data and will also be updated.
