The <u>Postsecondary: Progress Toward Sixty by 30</u> Education Focus Area combines data from the Lumina Foundation, National Student Clearinghouse, and CEPI to explore postsecondary enrollment, persistence, and completion rates of Michigan students. The report tracks progress toward Michigan's initiative to increase the percentage of Michigan adults with postsecondary

degrees or certificates to 60% by the year 2030.

• The <u>Postsecondary Student Data File</u> allows users with secure access to view student-level information on college enrollment, coursework, cumulative credit, program and award information, and GPAs for students from in-state and out-of-state colleges and universities.
