## Released to the Public

## 2021-22 Data

- The <u>Retained in Grade</u> report shows counts and percentages of students who were enrolled in the same grade level for two consecutive years.
- Annual counts and FTE of teachers, administrators, paraprofessionals and other staffing groups are included in the <u>Staffing Count</u> report. This includes breakouts by age range, longevity, race/ethnicity, gender and highest education level.
- The School Services and Offerings section of the <u>Parent Dashboard</u> contains information on schools' select programs and services collected from districts in the MSDS and the Points of Pride section of the Educational Entity Master.

### 2020-21 Data

- Data showing the number and percent of 3rd, 8th and 11th grade students who were proficient on the M-STEP, PSAT and SAT and were identified as "Section 31a At Risk" have been updated in the <u>At Risk Student</u> report.
- Data showing student achievement at Michigan's colleges and universities are found in the <u>College Degrees and Certificates Awarded</u> report.

## 2020-21 Data

• <u>College Remedial Coursework</u> shows the number of Michigan public high school graduates who took at least one remedial course after enrolling in a Michigan college or university the year after high school graduation. The report has been updated with 2020-21 postsecondary data for the 2019-20

high school graduation year.

 The <u>College Undergraduate Enrollment</u> report offers a closer look at undergraduates at Michigan's colleges and universities, including the number of degree-seeking students, student age, and whether students graduated from a Michigan public high school the year prior to enrollment.
