Released to the Public

2021-22 Data

- The [Retained in Grade](#) report shows counts and percentages of students who were enrolled in the same grade level for two consecutive years.
- Annual counts and FTE of teachers, administrators, paraprofessionals and other staffing groups are included in the [Staffing Count](#) report. This includes breakouts by age range, longevity, race/ethnicity, gender and highest education level.
- The **School Services and Offerings** section of the [Parent Dashboard](#) contains information on schools' select programs and services collected from districts in the MSDS and the Points of Pride section of the Educational Entity Master.

2020-21 Data

- Data showing the number and percent of 3rd, 8th and 11th grade students who were proficient on the M-STEP, PSAT and SAT and were identified as "Section 31a At Risk" have been updated in the [At Risk Student](#) report.
