### 2020-21

- The Postsecondary <u>Success Rates</u> report shows the number of degree-seeking students achieving successful outcomes at Michigan's public universities and community colleges. Successes include earning a certificate, associate, or bachelor's degree at a public university or community college or transferring to a 4-year institution as a degree-seeking student from a community college. These rates capture both part- and full-time enrollment, as well as mobility between institutions.
- The Community College Demographic Enrollment Profile data file on the <u>Community College Data</u> page shows the number of students enrolling in and receiving degrees at Michigan community colleges by age, gender and race/ethnicity.
