Charity Game Tickets (Bingo Bug)

BACKGROUND

Each deal of Bingo Bug contains 400 tickets and a seal card. Instant winners are contained throughout the deal. In addition, twenty-two tickets, randomly distributed throughout each deal contain a ladybug number. Players retain these tickets for a chance to win a minimum of \$150.

The seal card has five windows. The top window conceals a ladybug number. The remaining four windows on the bottom of the seal card are numbered 1 through 4. Three of those windows conceal the word "SORRY" and one conceals the words "YOU WIN."

The progressive jackpot starts at \$25 and increases in increments of \$25 for each additional deal sold. The progressive jackpot shall not exceed \$425.

The progressive jackpot is awarded when the winner of the ladybug prize correctly selects the window revealing "YOU WIN."

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Only one deal may be sold at a time.
2. A new progressive jackpot may not be started until the prior progressive jackpot is won.
3. The progressive jackpot prize shall start at \$25 and increase by \$25 for each deal sold until the prize is won.
4. The progressive jackpot should continue either during that same bingo occasion or during the licensee's next bingo occasion until the progressive jackpot is won.
5. The progressive jackpot shall not exceed \$425.

GAME CONDUCT

6. Players that have a ladybug number should retain that ticket until all tickets in the deal have been sold.
7. Before playing the seal card:
 - a. All tickets in the deal must be sold.
 - b. The worker announces that the seal card play on Bingo Bug will begin and gives the serial number of the deal that is being played.
8. The worker opens the window on the seal card that conceals the winning ladybug number, announces the number, and shows it to two or more players.
9. The player with the corresponding ladybug number is the winner and is awarded \$150.
10. The worker announces the amount of the progressive jackpot.
11. The ladybug winner then chooses ONLY ONE of the four windows numbered 1 through 4 from the seal card.

12. The worker opens the selected window and reads to all players either "SORRY" or "YOU WIN" and shows it to two or more players.
13. If "YOU WIN" is revealed, the ladybug winner is awarded the progressive jackpot.
14. If "SORRY" is revealed, the next deal of Bingo Bug will have a progressive jackpot that is increased by \$25.
15. If the Bingo Bug ticket with the winning ladybug number cannot be located when it is called:
 - a. A neutral player may select one of the windows numbered 1 through 4.
 - b. The worker opens the selected window and reads to all players either "SORRY" or "YOU WIN" and shows the seal card to two or more players.
 - c. The worker announces that the ladybug winner must claim the prize(s) within the time posted by the licensee (not less than 14 days from the date the last ticket in that deal was sold).

FINAL DEAL

16. If a licensee will close permanently or for an extended period of time, the progressive jackpot reaches the \$425 maximum, OR if the licensee has other reasons to end a Bingo Bug progression, a final deal must be played in which an announcement is made prior to the sale that the ladybug winner will automatically win the progressive jackpot.

RESTRICTIONS

17. Prizes must be claimed within the time posted by the licensee but shall not be less than 14 days from the date the last ticket in that deal was sold.
18. Seal cards must be retained until the winner(s) have been determined or the prize claim period has expired, whichever comes first, and there are no disputes.

PRIZE PAYOUT

18. Each deal of Bingo Bug contains the following:

Takes In:	\$400.00 per deal (400 tickets @ \$1.00 each)
Pays Out:	\$300.00 per deal
Gross Profit:	\$100.00 per deal
% Payout:	75.00% per deal
% Profit (Net):	15.00% per deal
Winning Ticket Ratio:	1 in 3.92 per deal

<u>Number Of Tickets</u>	<u>Prize Amount</u>	<u>Winning Combination</u>
1	\$150.00	Ladybug Winner
1	\$25.00	Jackpot Allocation
1	\$20.00	Two Bees
6	\$2.00	Two Spiders
93	\$1.00	Two of any other same bug

DISPUTED GAMES

19. If a player has a complaint involving Bingo Bug, log the issue along with the name(s) of player(s) involved and retain the seal card. Maintain with the game records.

GAME RECORDS

20. Record each deal sold of Bingo Bug on the Bingo Bug Progressive Jackpot Accountability form until the progressive jackpot is won.
21. Keep the completed form with the game records for that week.
22. Start a new form each time the progressive jackpot is won.
